Fig 1.1 New Entrants (Full-time) by Faculty and Sex, 2013/2014

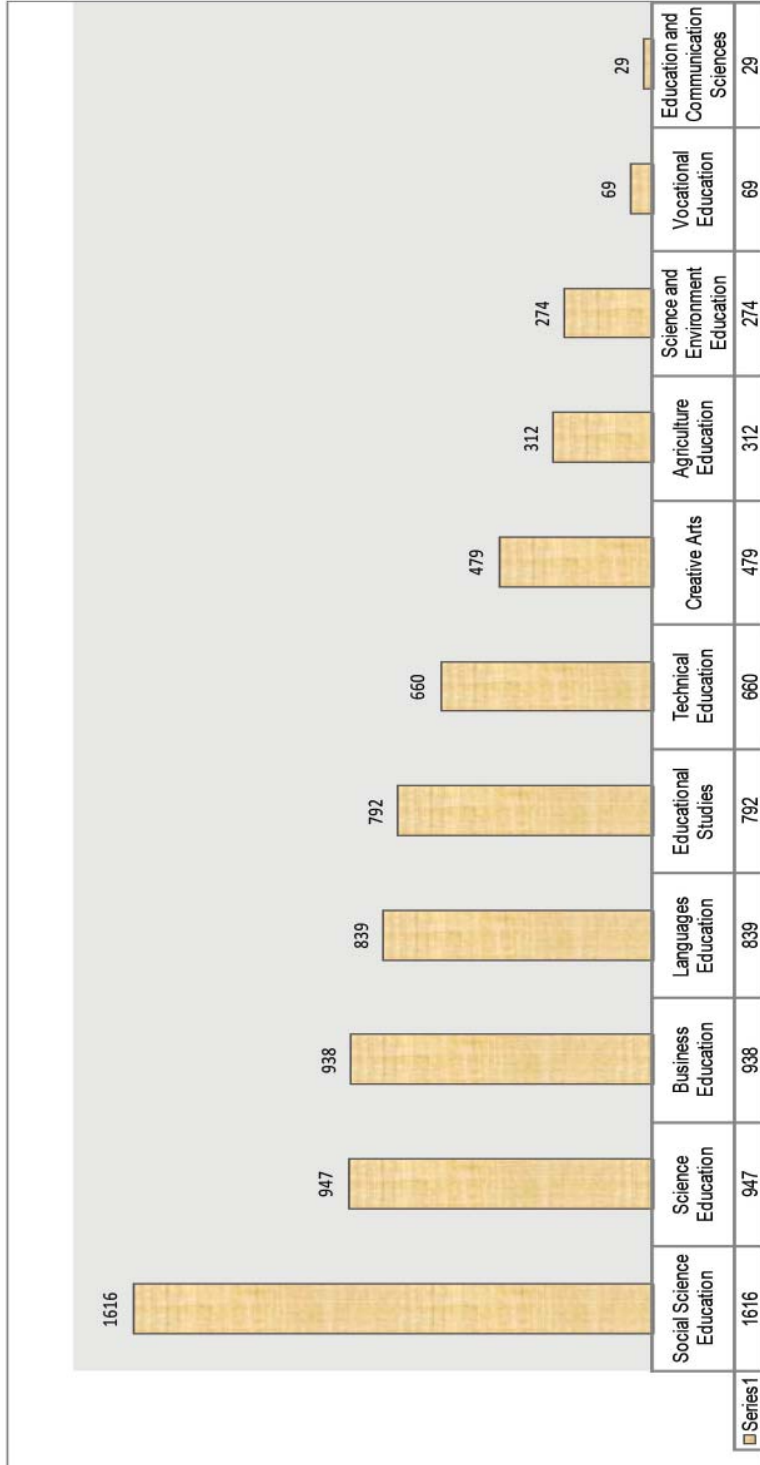

FIG. 1.2 Trend of New Entrants (Full-Time) By Sex, 1992/93 - 2013/14

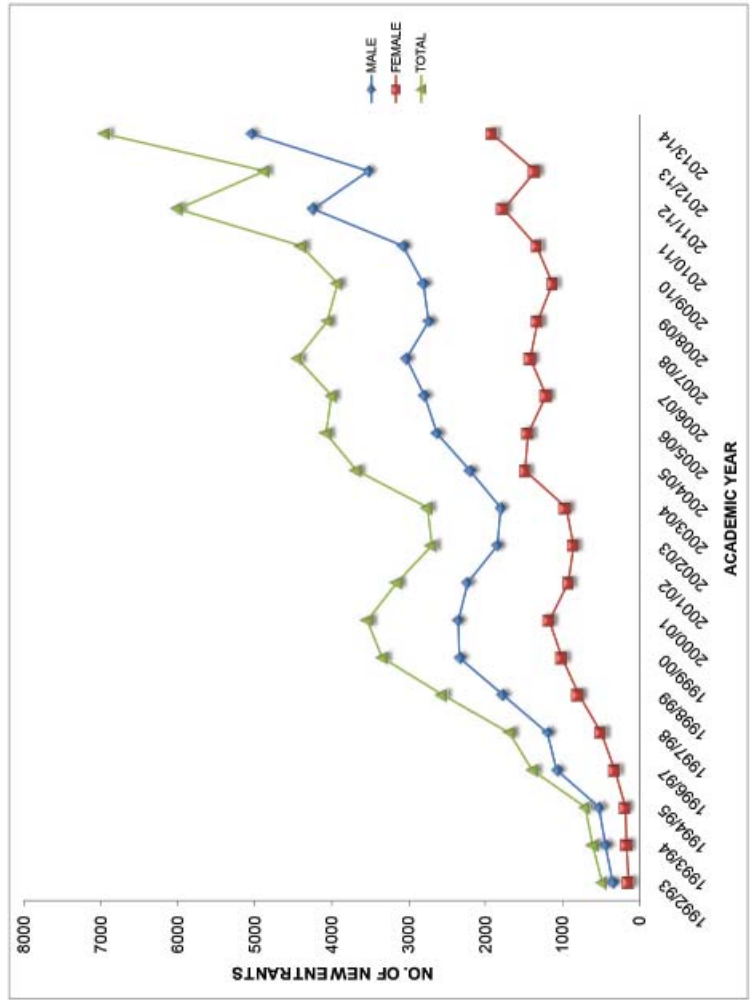

FIG. 1.3 Full-Time Students' Enrolment by Faculty, 2013/2014

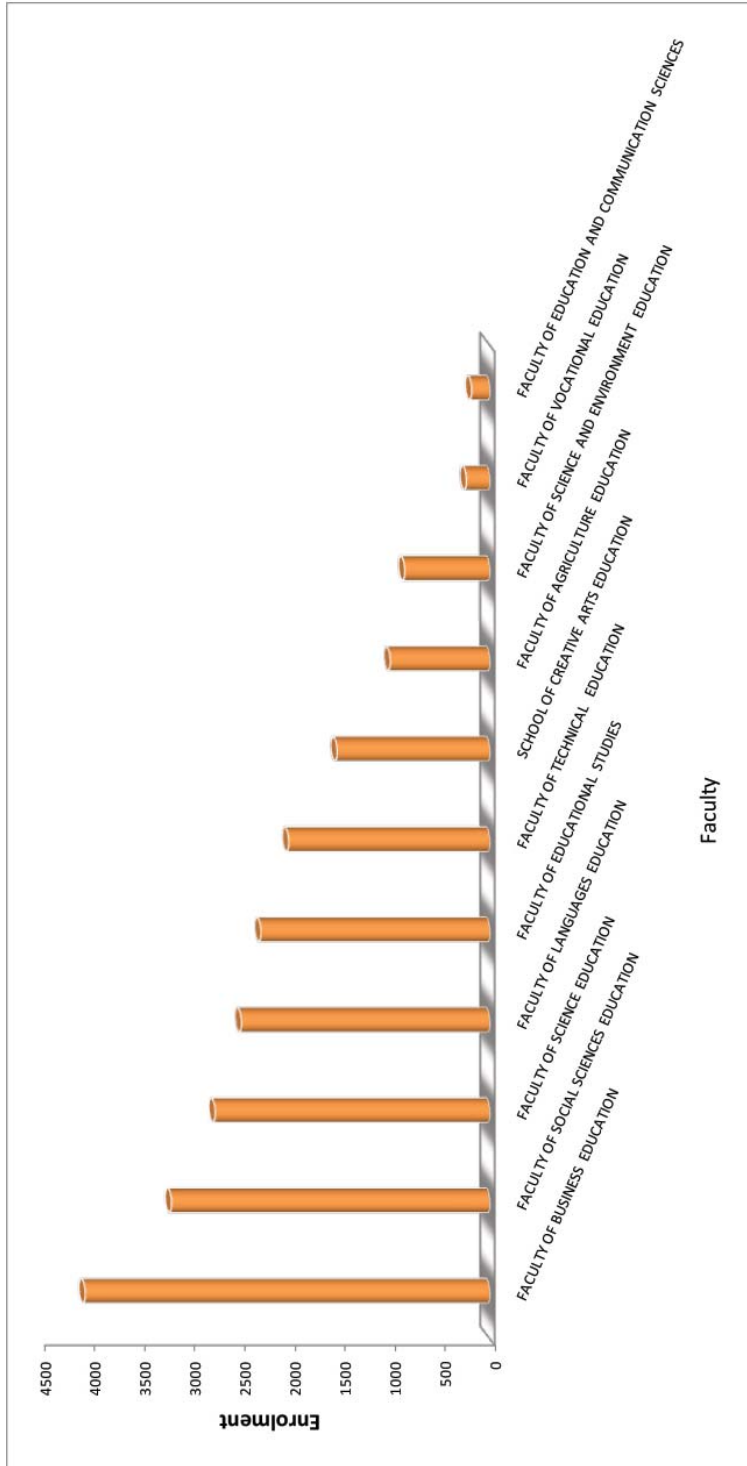

FIG. 1.4 Distance Education Students' Enrolment by Study Centres, 2013/2014

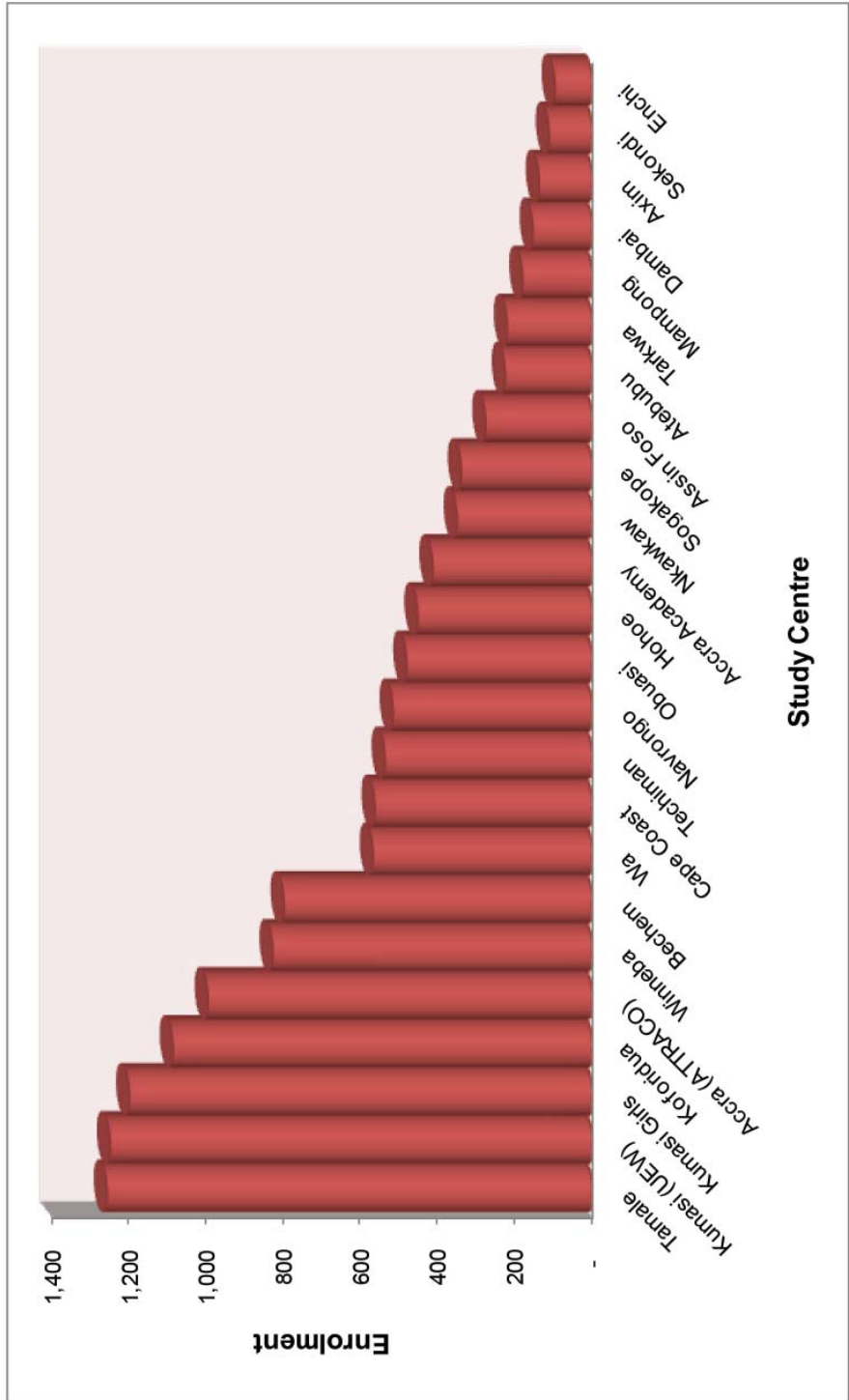


FIG. 1.5 Distance Education Students' Enrolment by Sex, 2013/2014

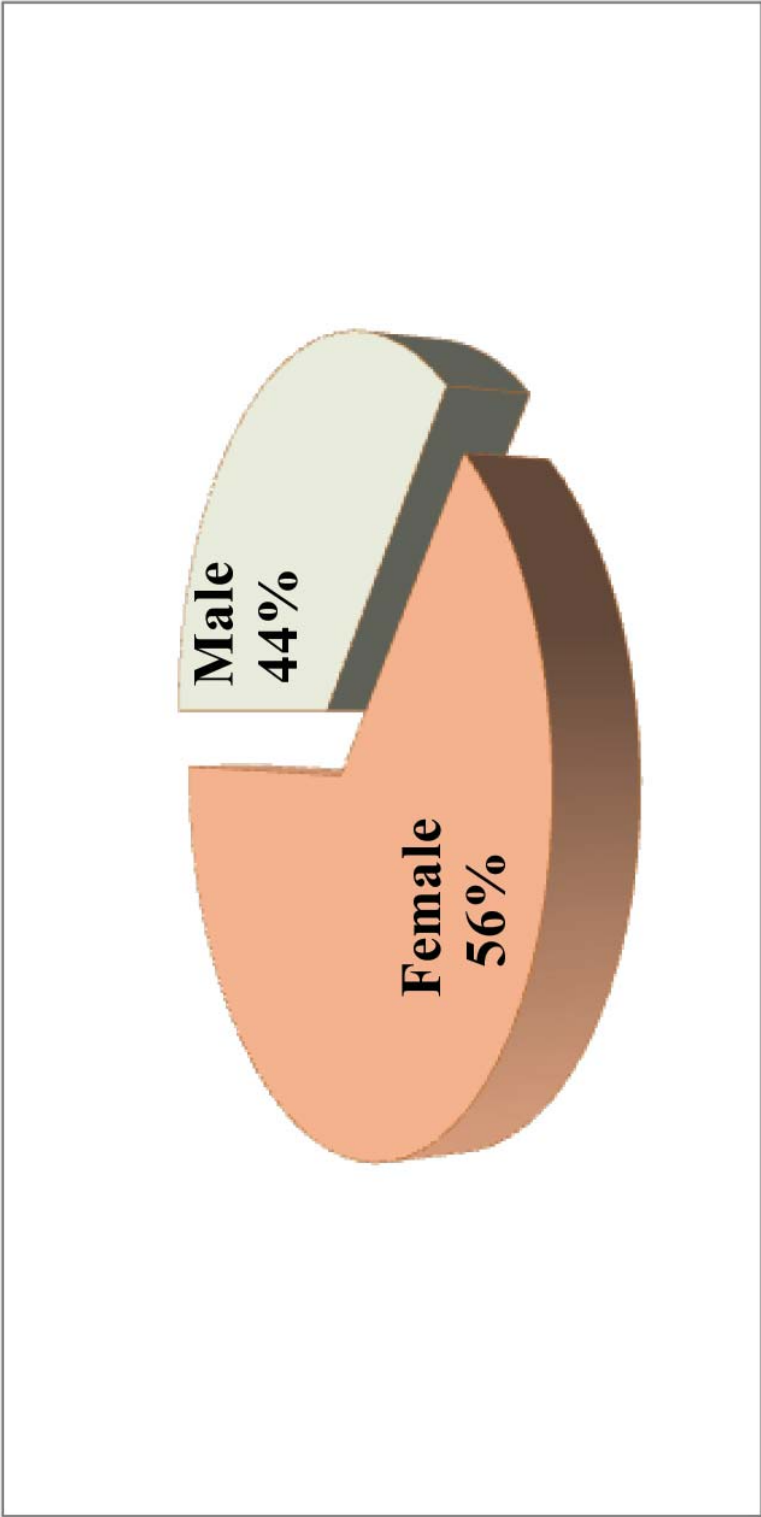

FIG. 2.1: Academic Staff Pyramid

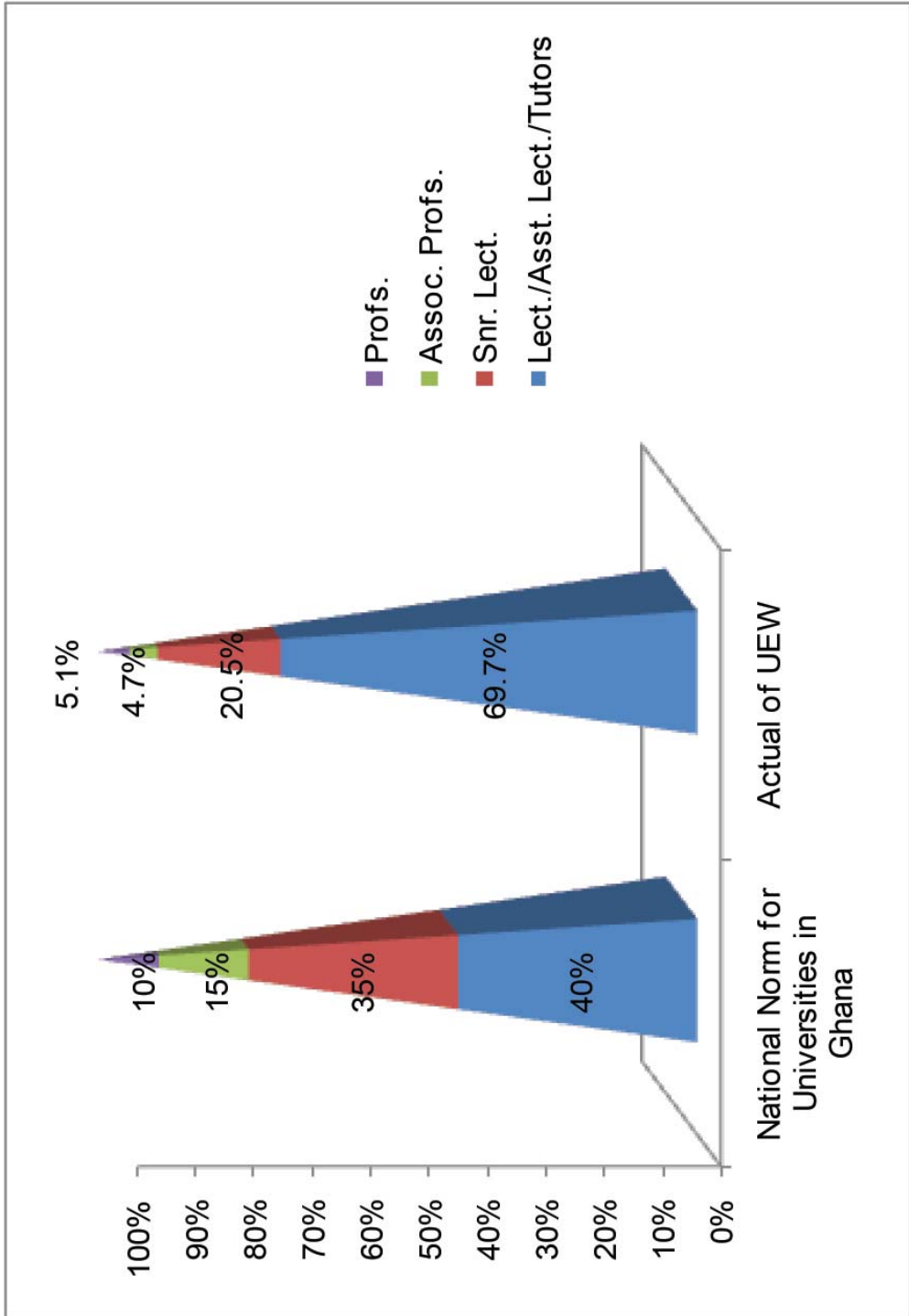

FIG. 2.2: Staffing Summary (as at July 31, 2014)

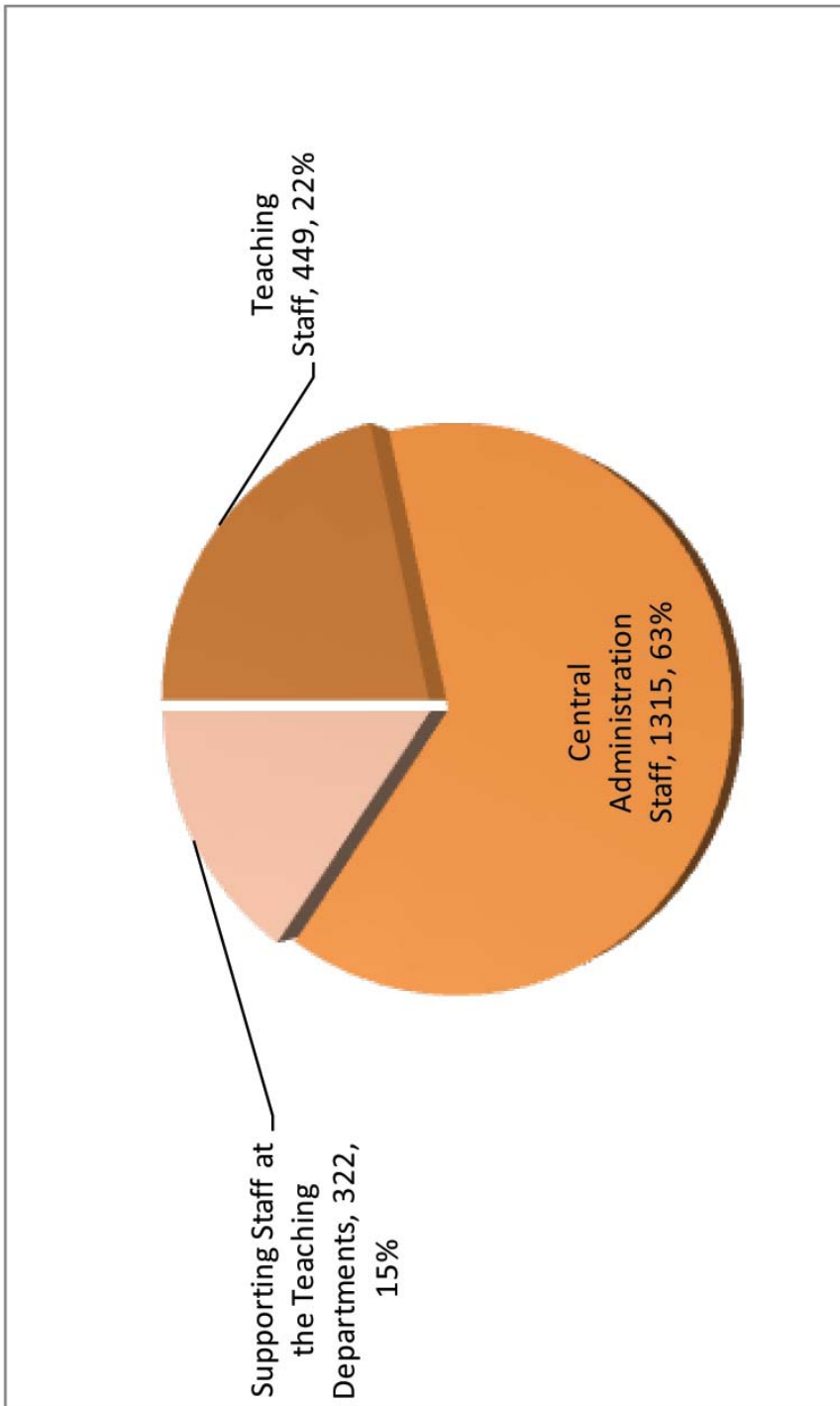
