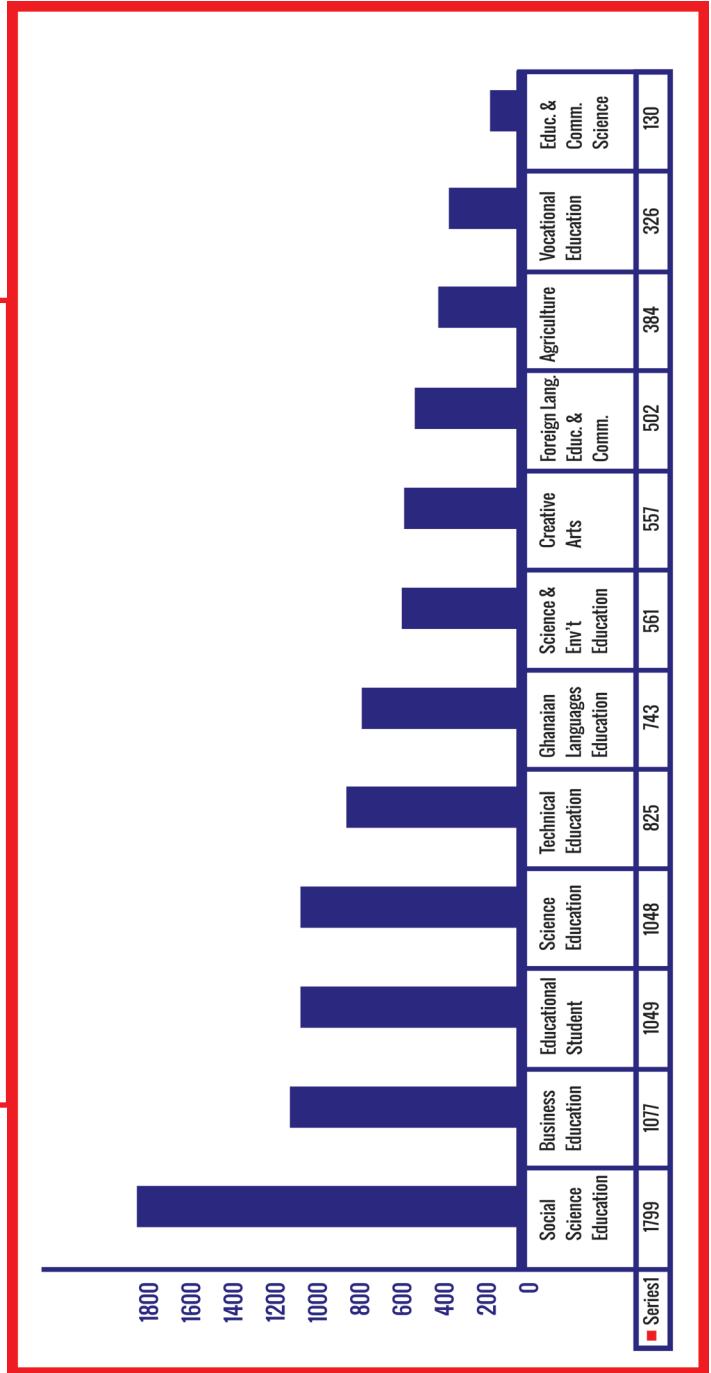

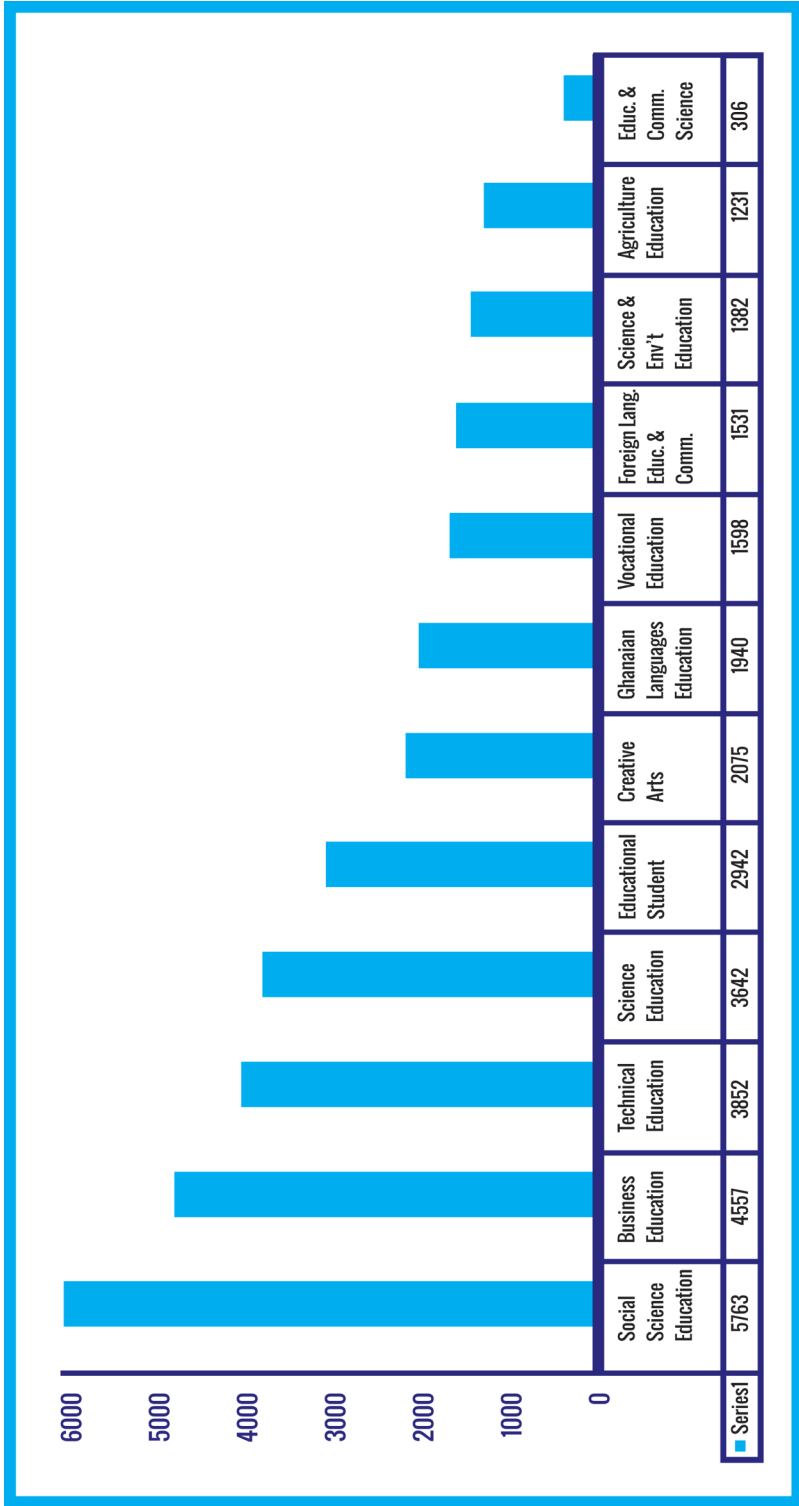
**FIGURE 1: NEW ENTRANTS BY FACULTY AND SEX, 2015 /2016**

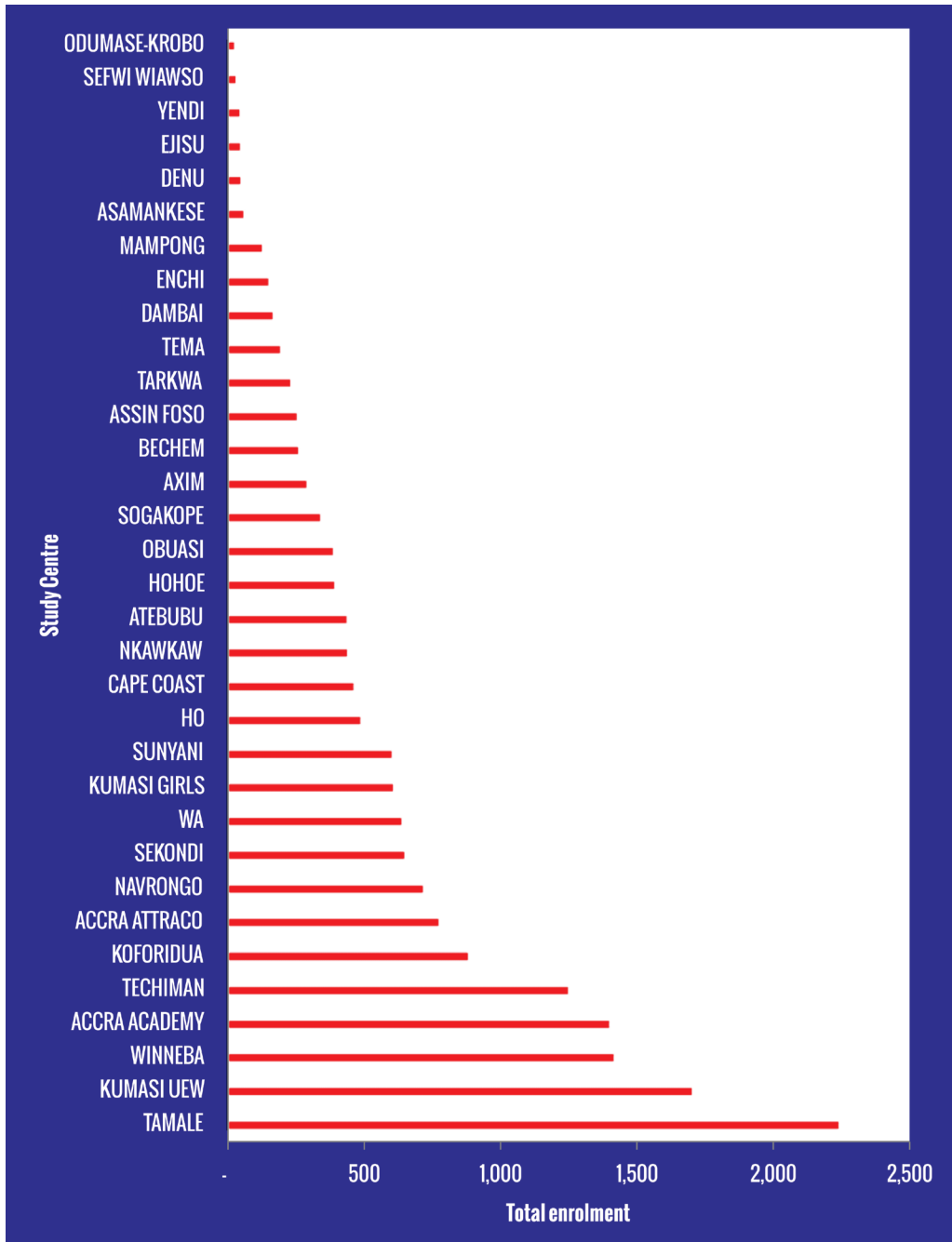

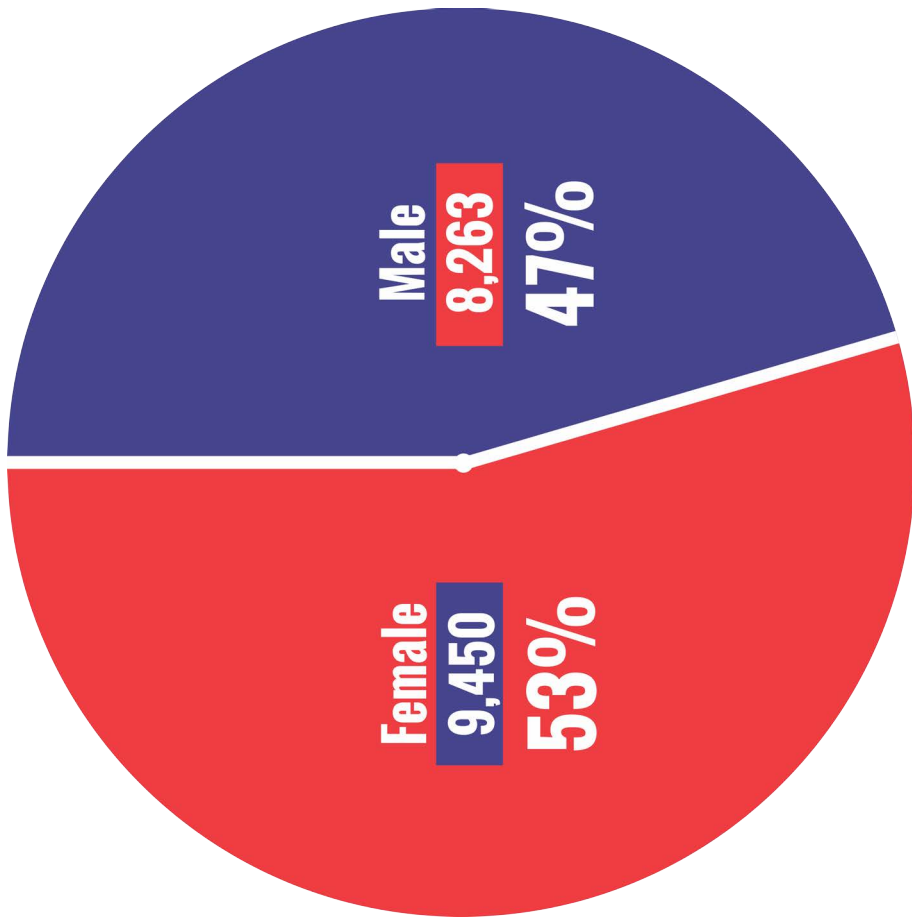

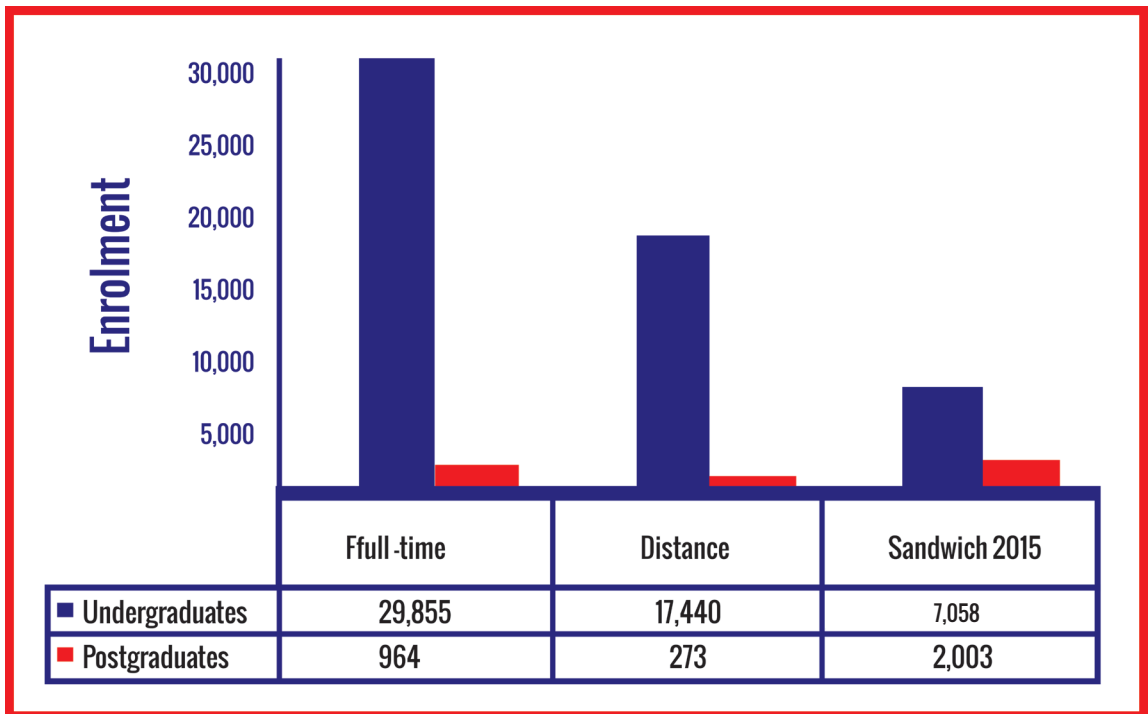

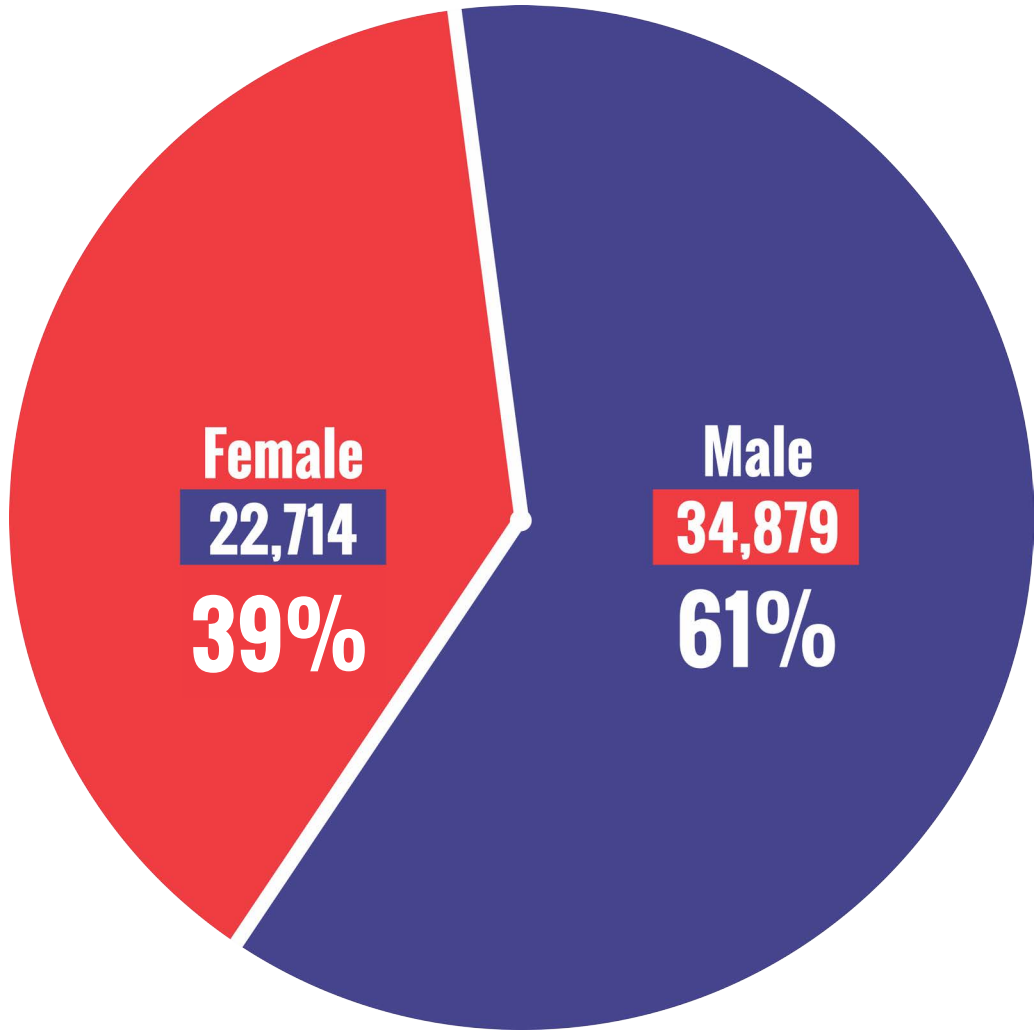

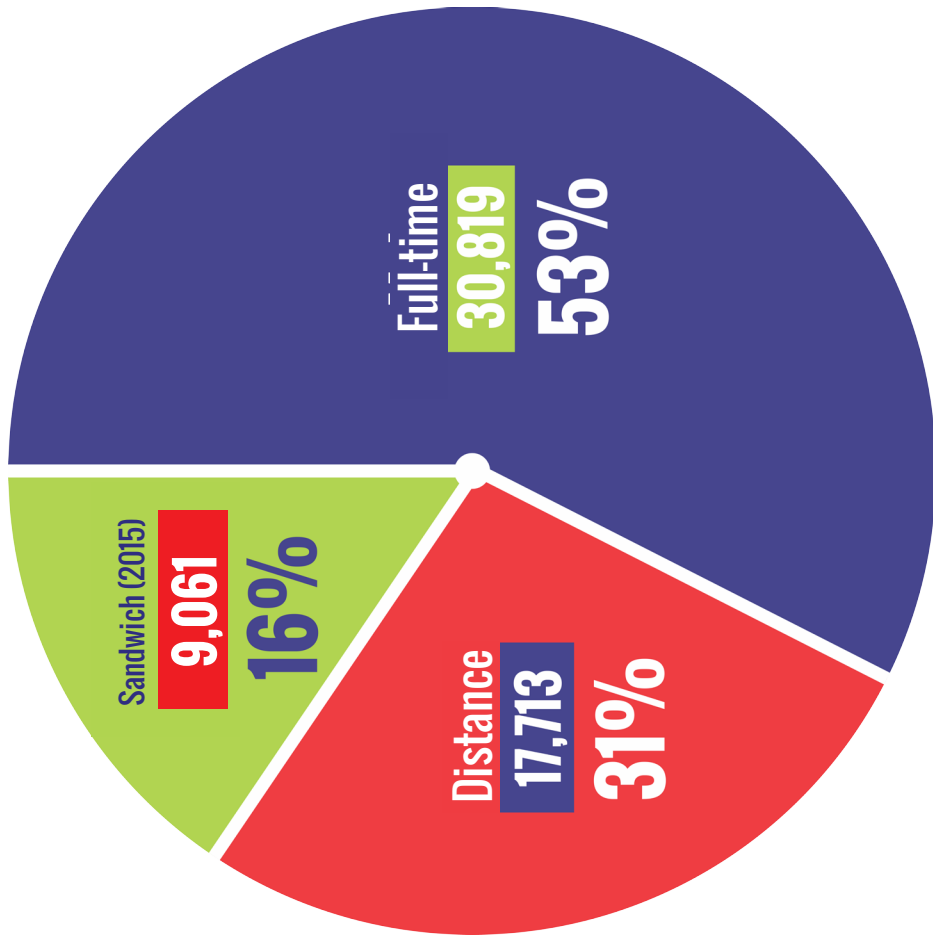
FIGURE 5: SUMMARY OF STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY PROGRAMME AND MODE OF STUDY, 2015/2016



**FIGURE 6: SUMMARY OF OVERALL STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY SEX, 2015/2016**



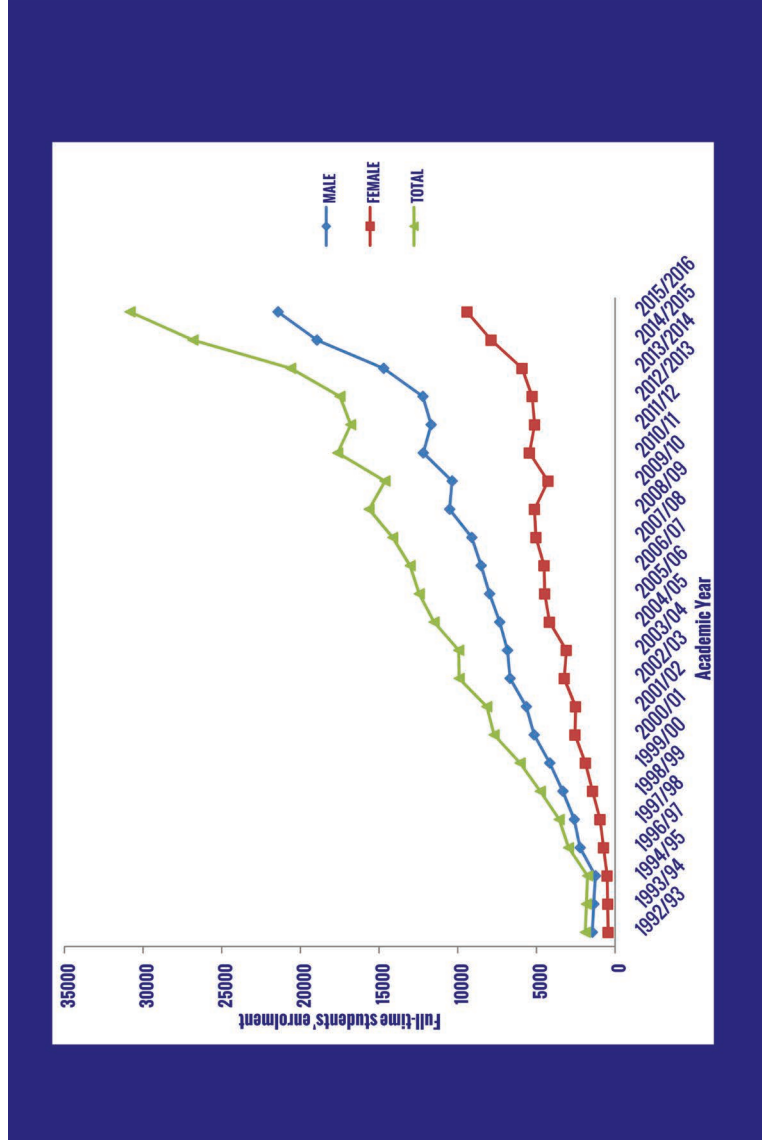
**FIGURE 7: SUMMARY OF OVERALL STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY MODE OF STUDY, 2015/2016**

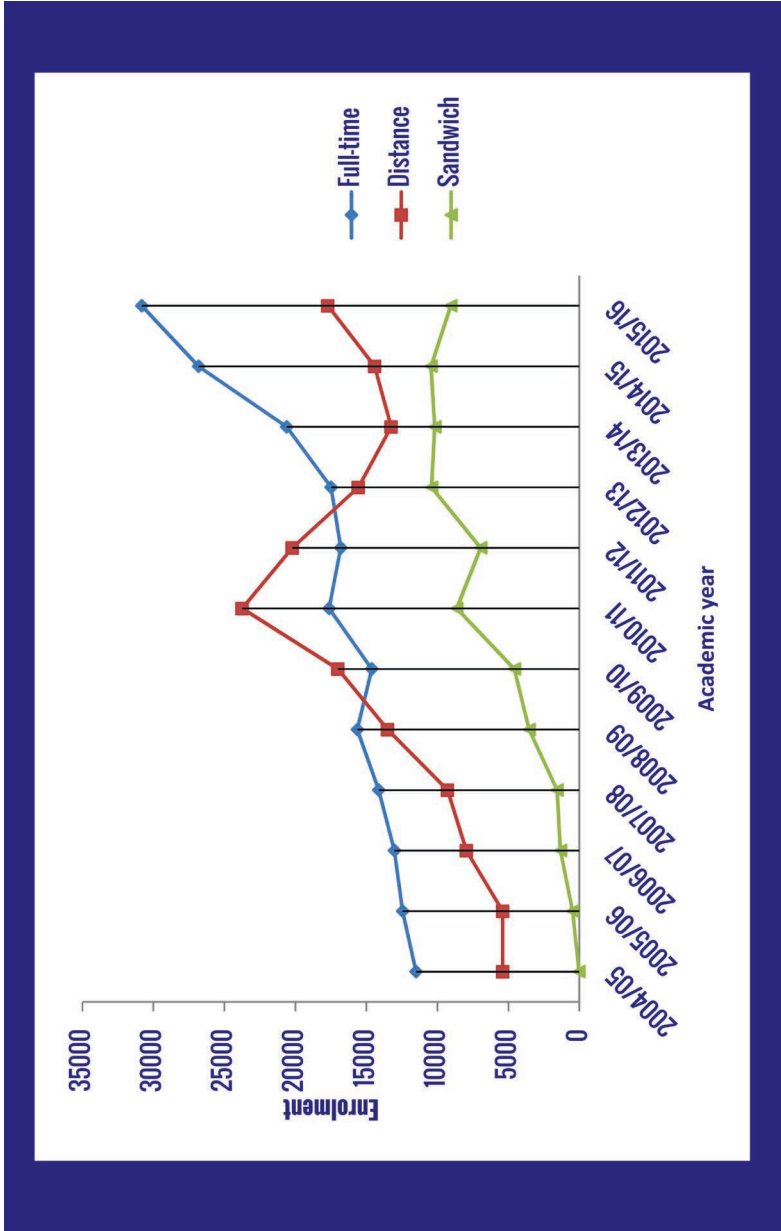
**FIGURE 8: TREND IN FULL-TIME STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY SEX, 1992 / 1993 - 2015 / 2016**

**FIGURE 9: TREND IN STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY MODE OF STUDY, 2004/2005 - 2015/2016**



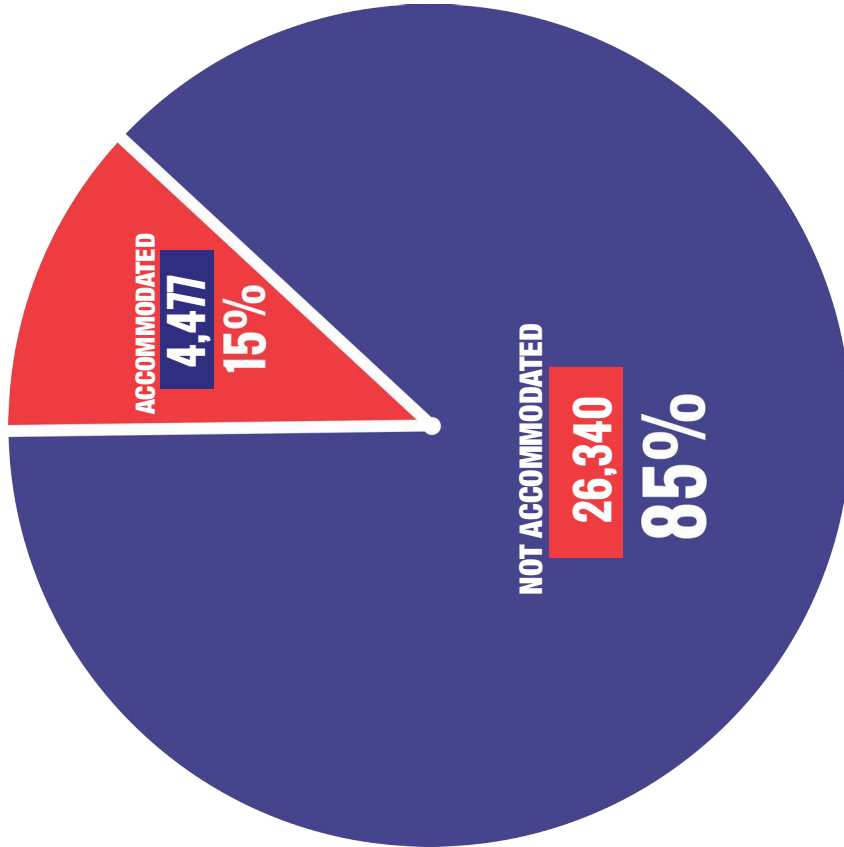

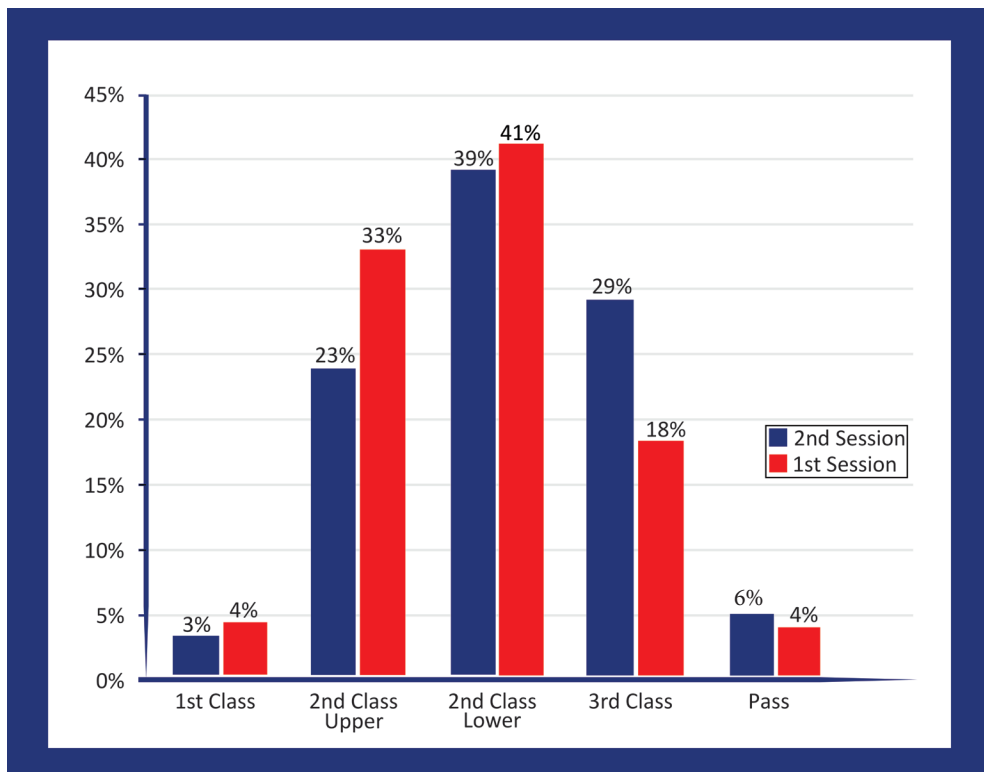

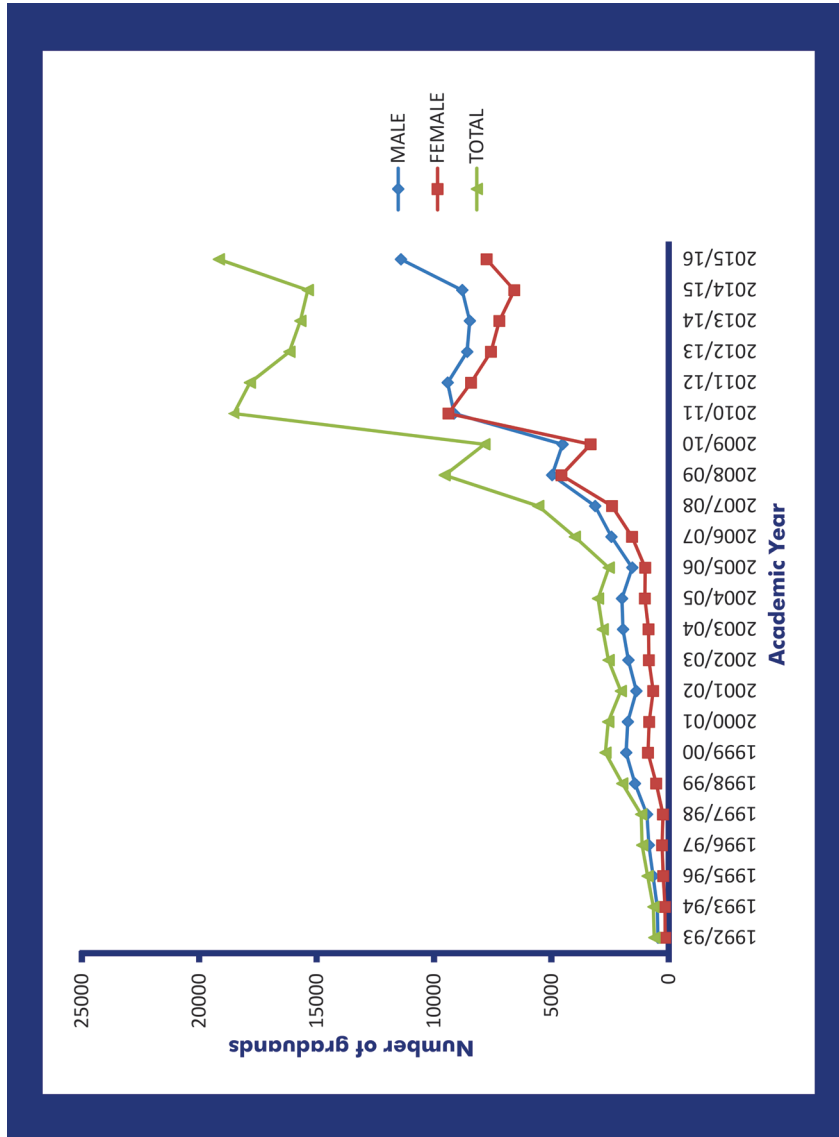

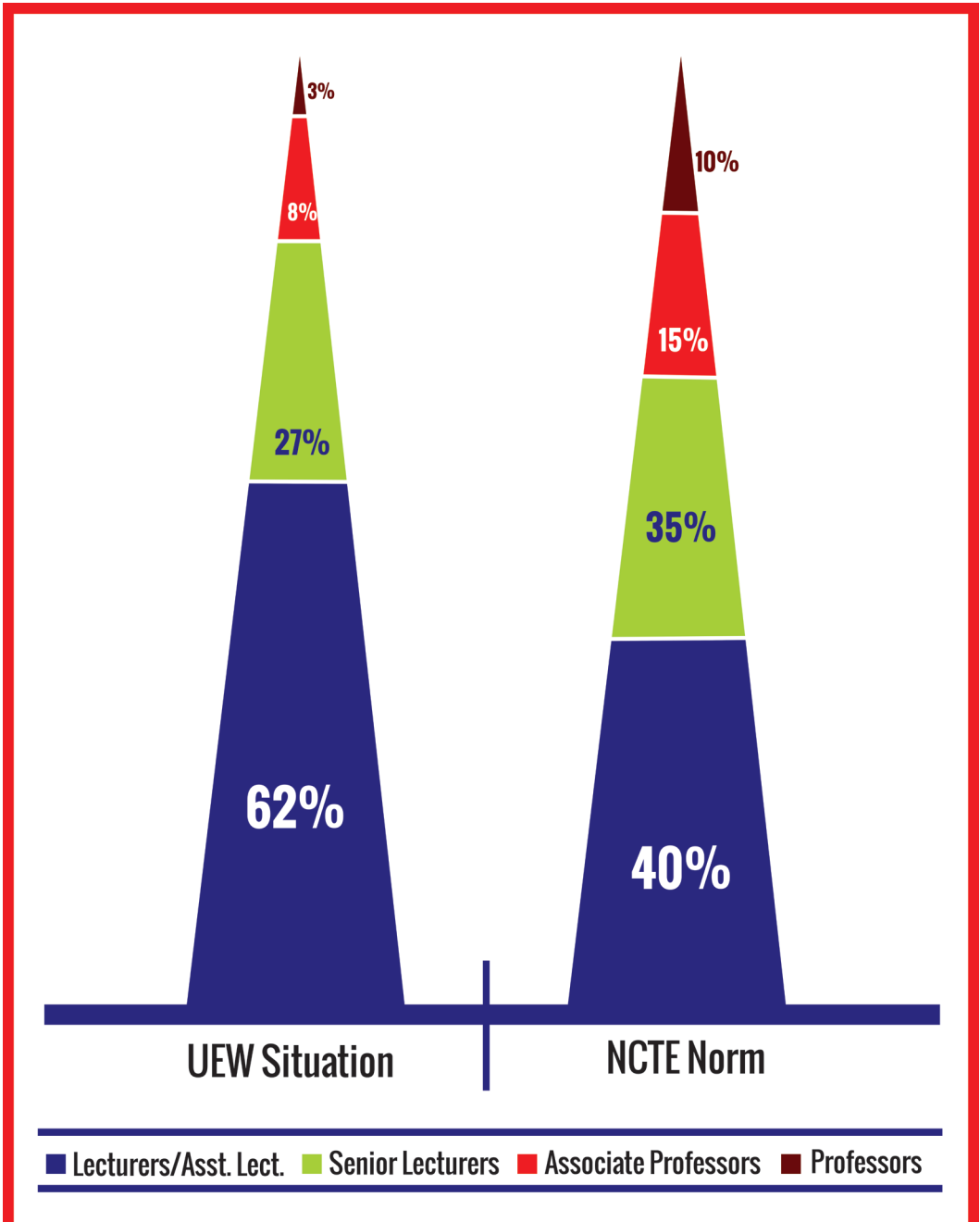
