FIGURE 1: NEW ENTRANTS BY FACULTY AND SEX, 2014/2015

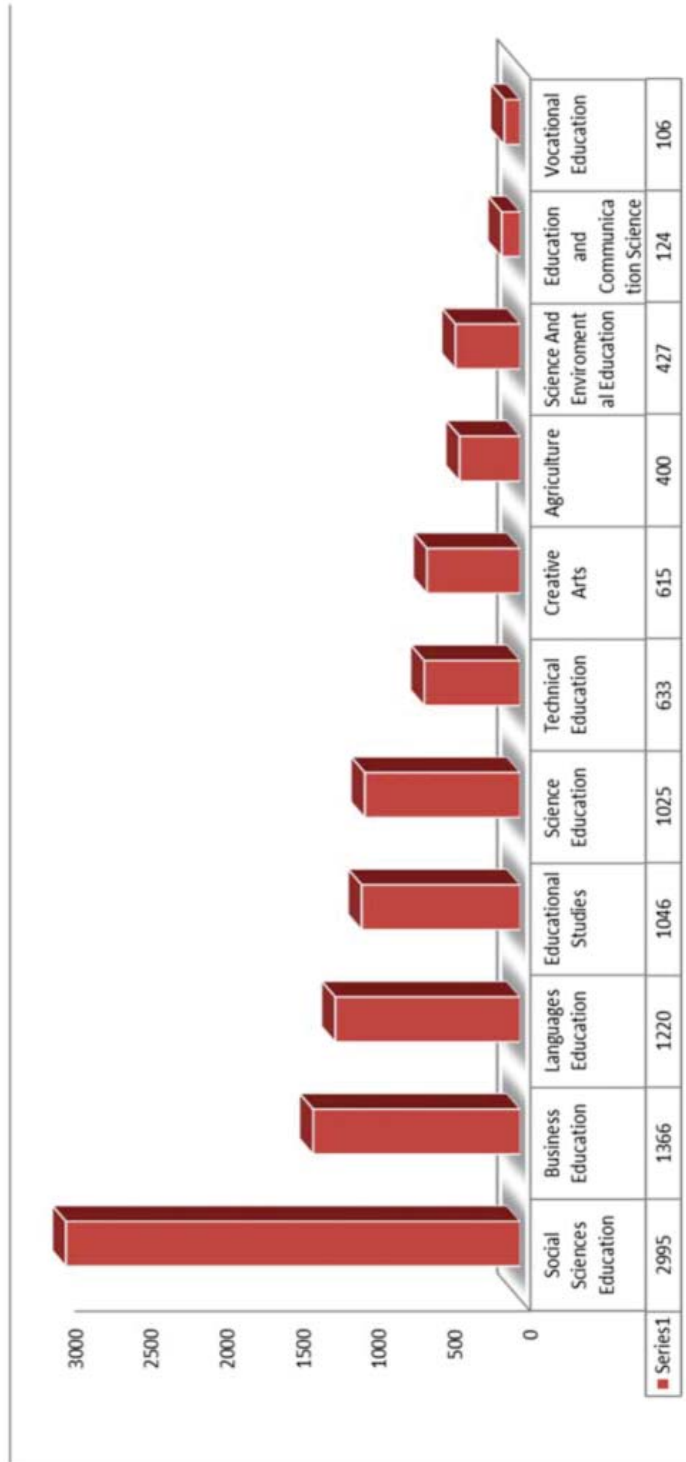

FIGURE 2: SUMMARY OF FULL-TIME STUDENTS' ENROLMENT, 2014/2015

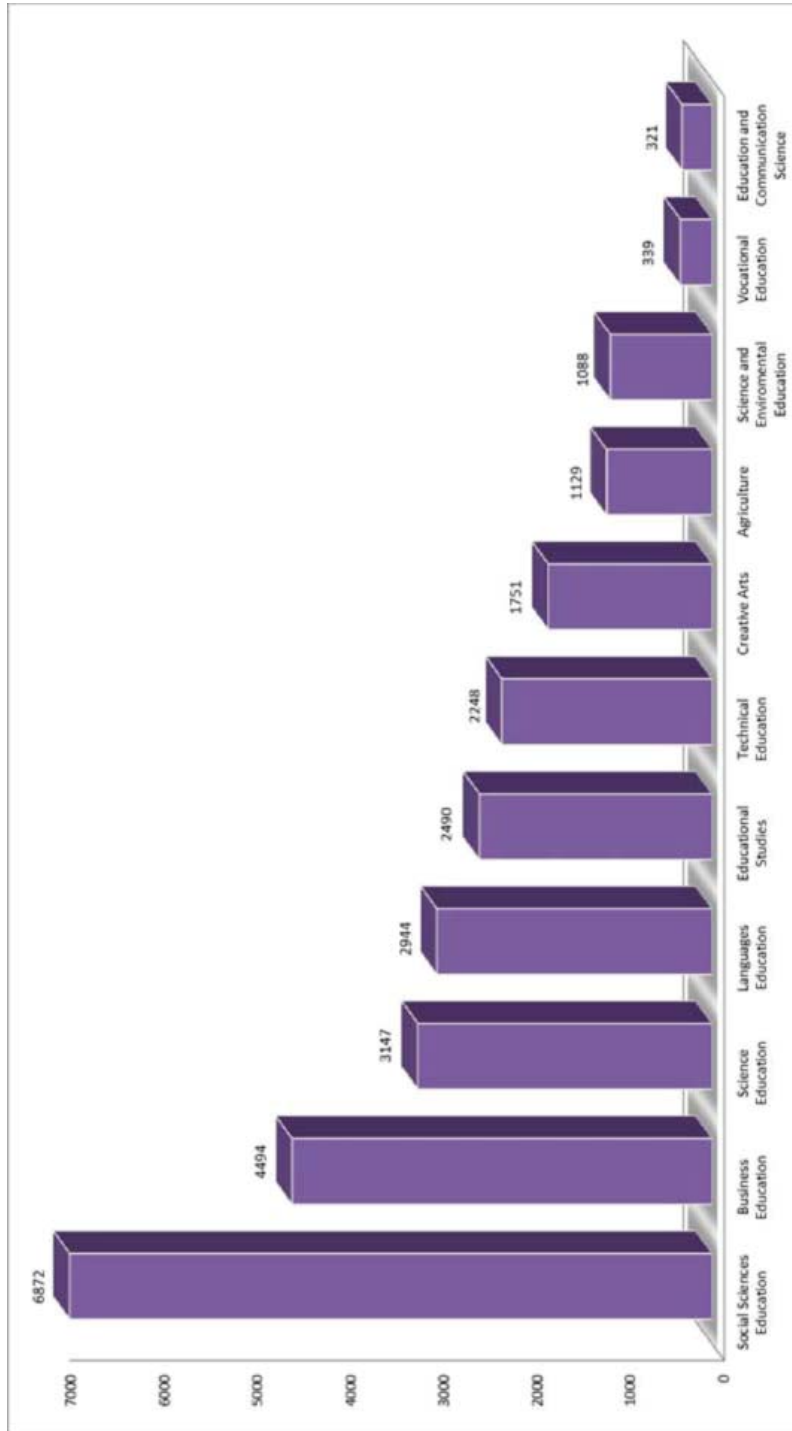

FIGURE 3: DISTANCE STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY STUDY CENTRES, 2014/2015

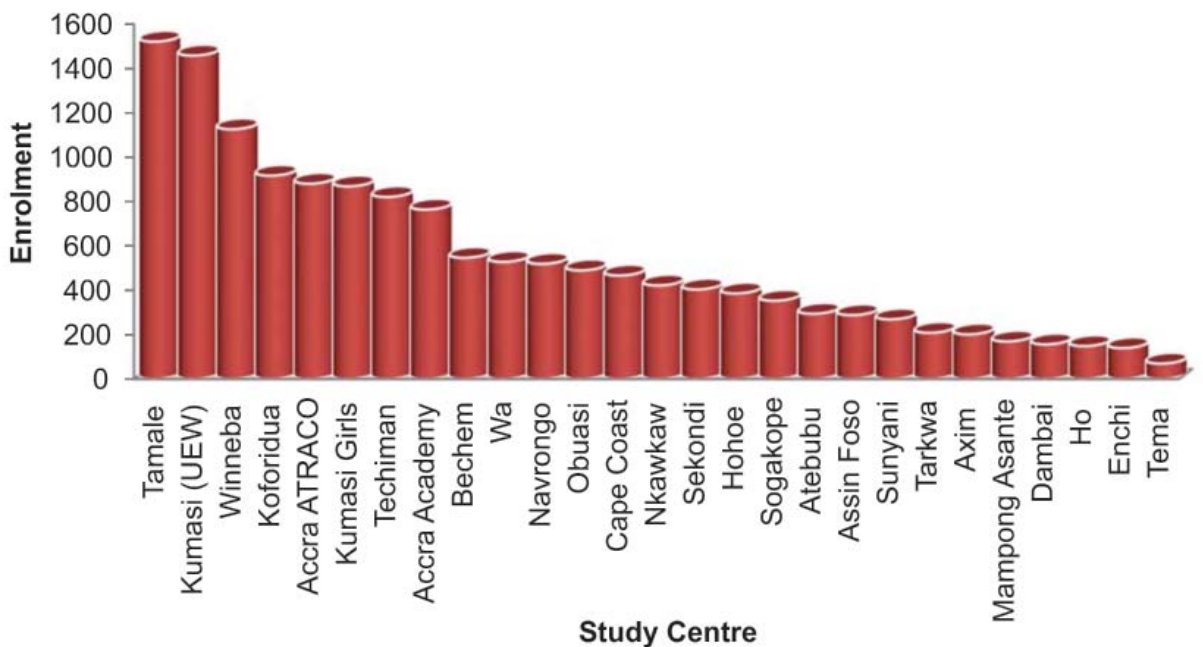
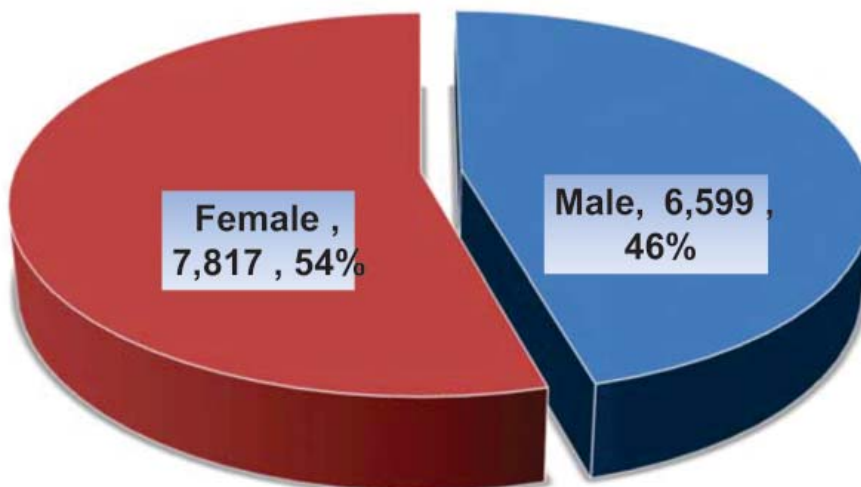


FIGURE 4: DISTANCE STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY SEX, 2014/2015**TABLE 9: STUDENTS' ENROLMENT FOR SANDWICH PROGRAMMES BY SEX AND FACULTY, (2014 SANDWICH SESSION)**

FIGURE 5: SUMMARY OF STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY MODE OF STUDY, 2014/2015

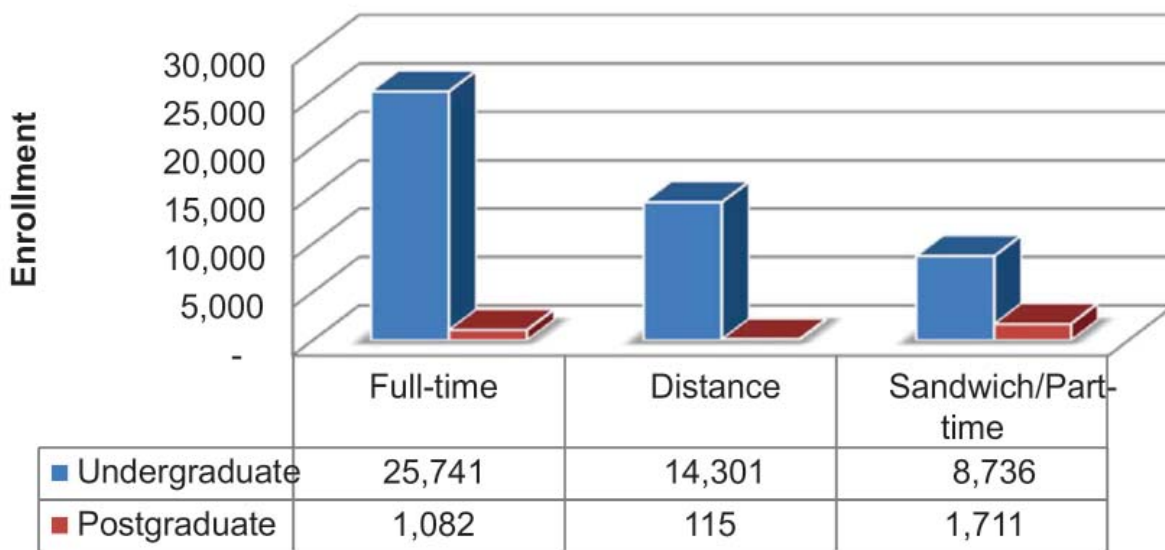


FIGURE 6: SUMMARY OF OVERALL STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY SEX, 2014/2015

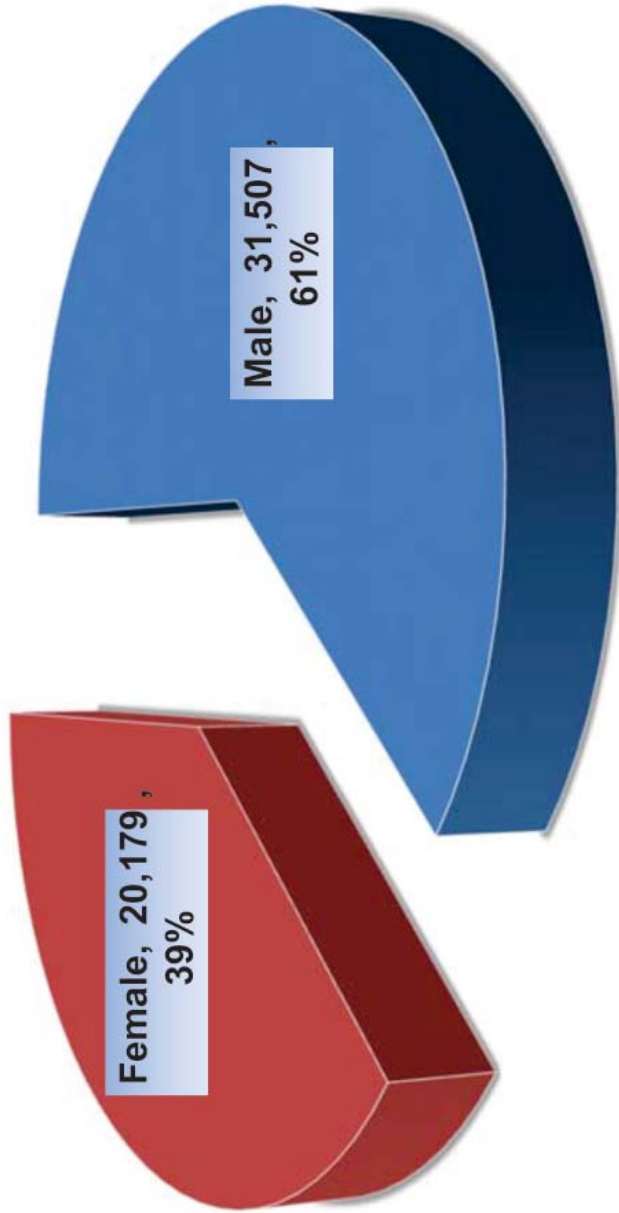


FIGURE 7: SUMMARY OF OVERALL STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY MODE OF STUDY, 2014/2015

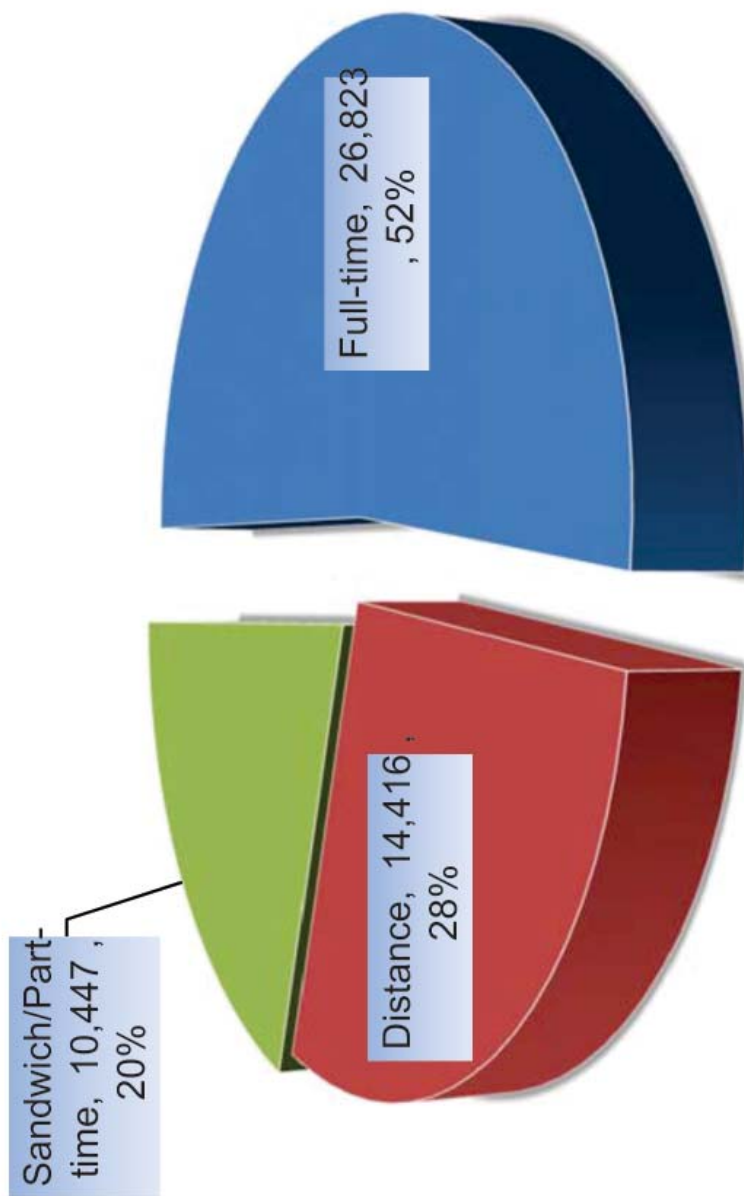

FIGURE 8: TREND IN FULL-TIME STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY SEX 1992/1993 - 2014/2015

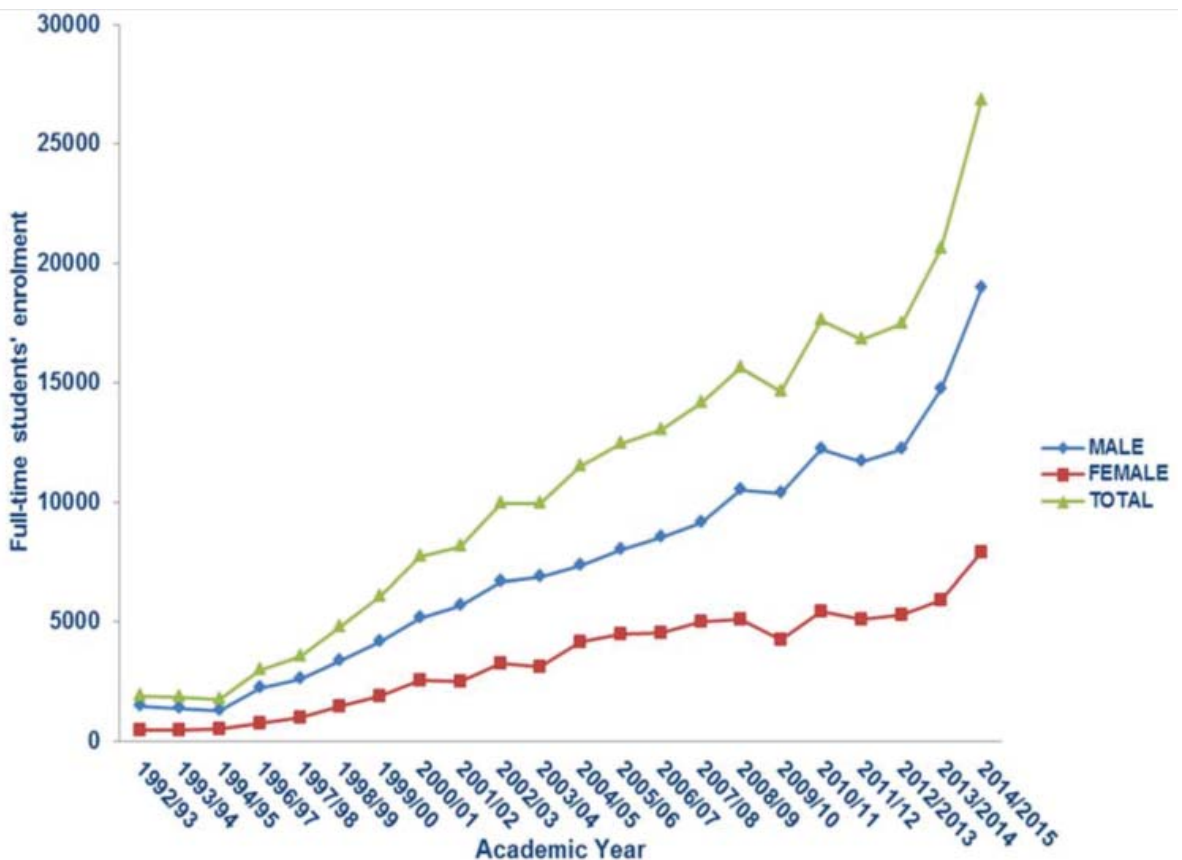

FIGURE 9: TREND IN STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY MODE OF STUDY, 2004/2005-2014/2015

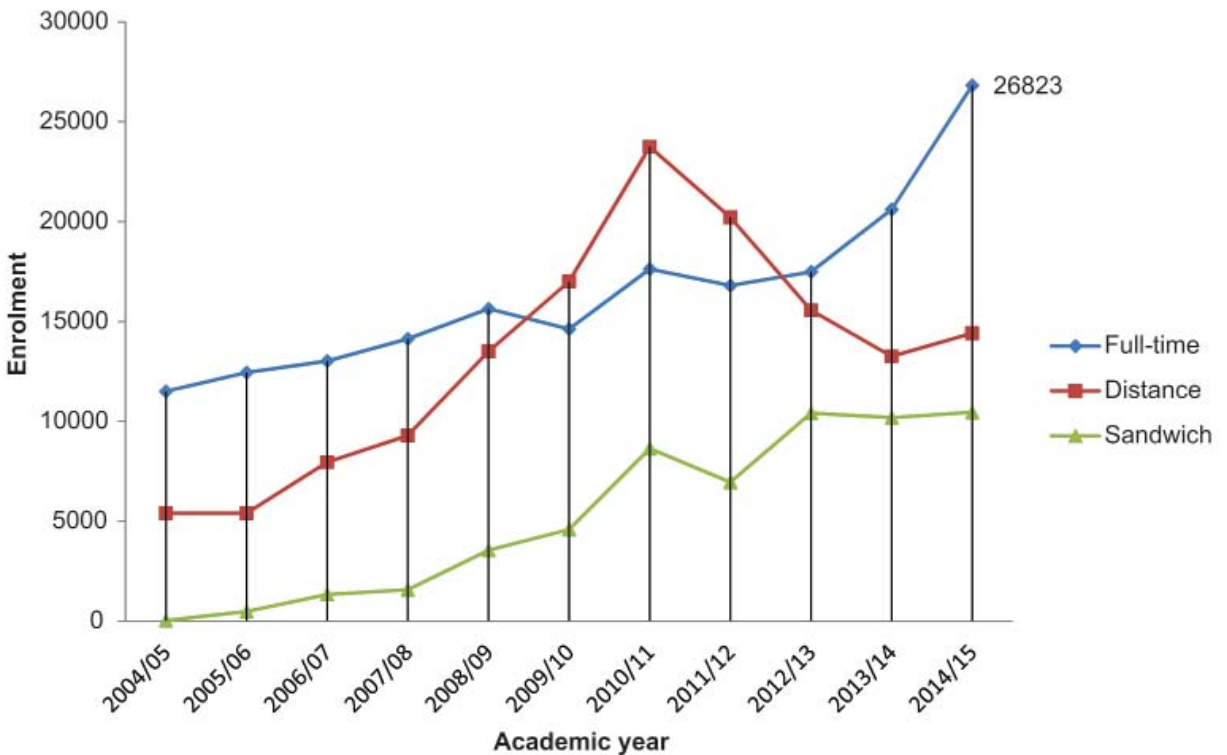

FIGURE 10: STUDENTS' RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION, 2014/2015

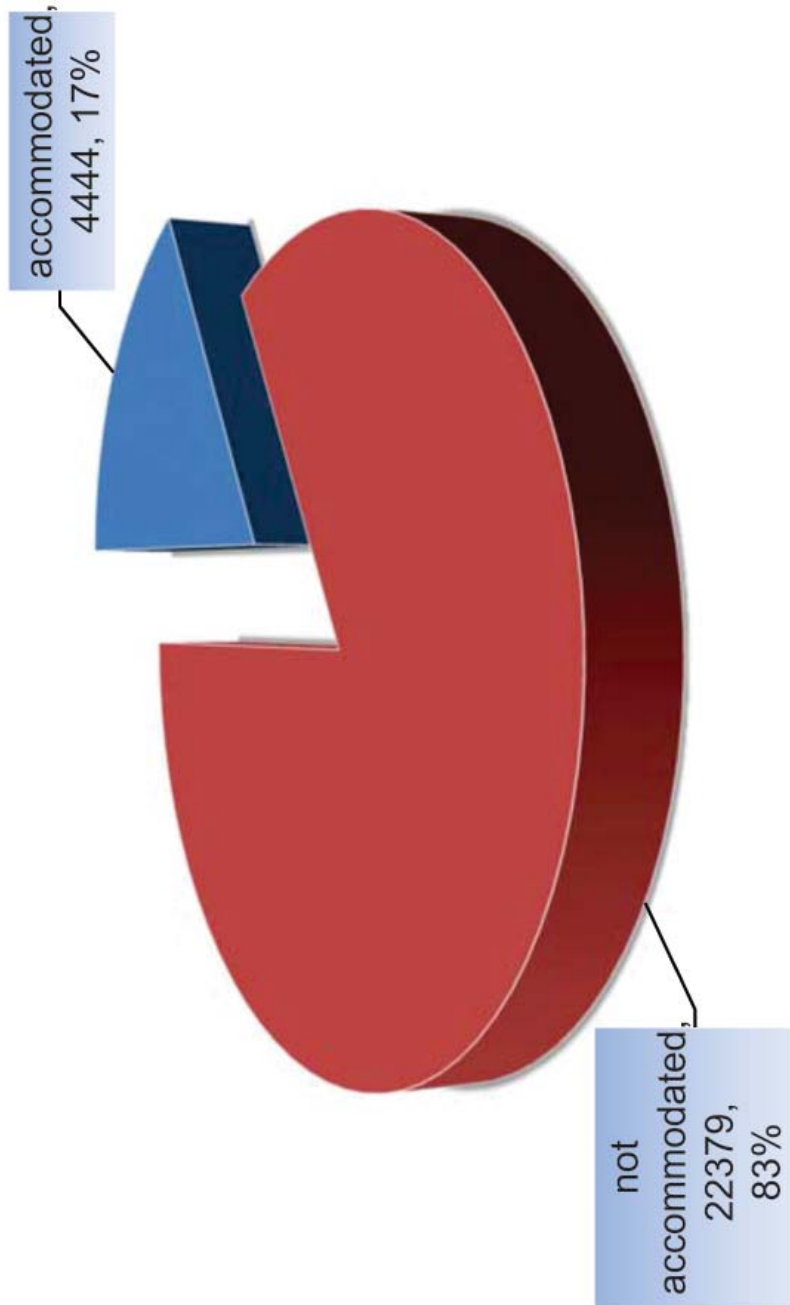

FIGURE 11: FIRST DEGREE AWARDS BY CLASS, 2014/2015

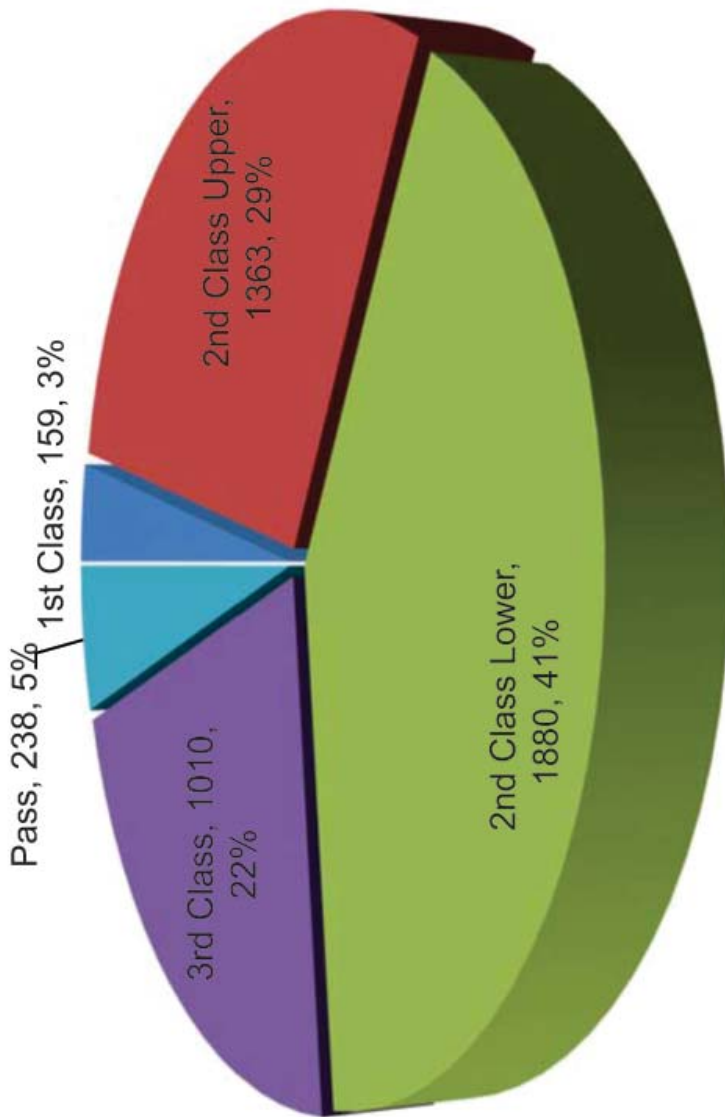

FIGURE 12: TREND IN GRADUATE OUTPUT 1992/93 - 2014/2015

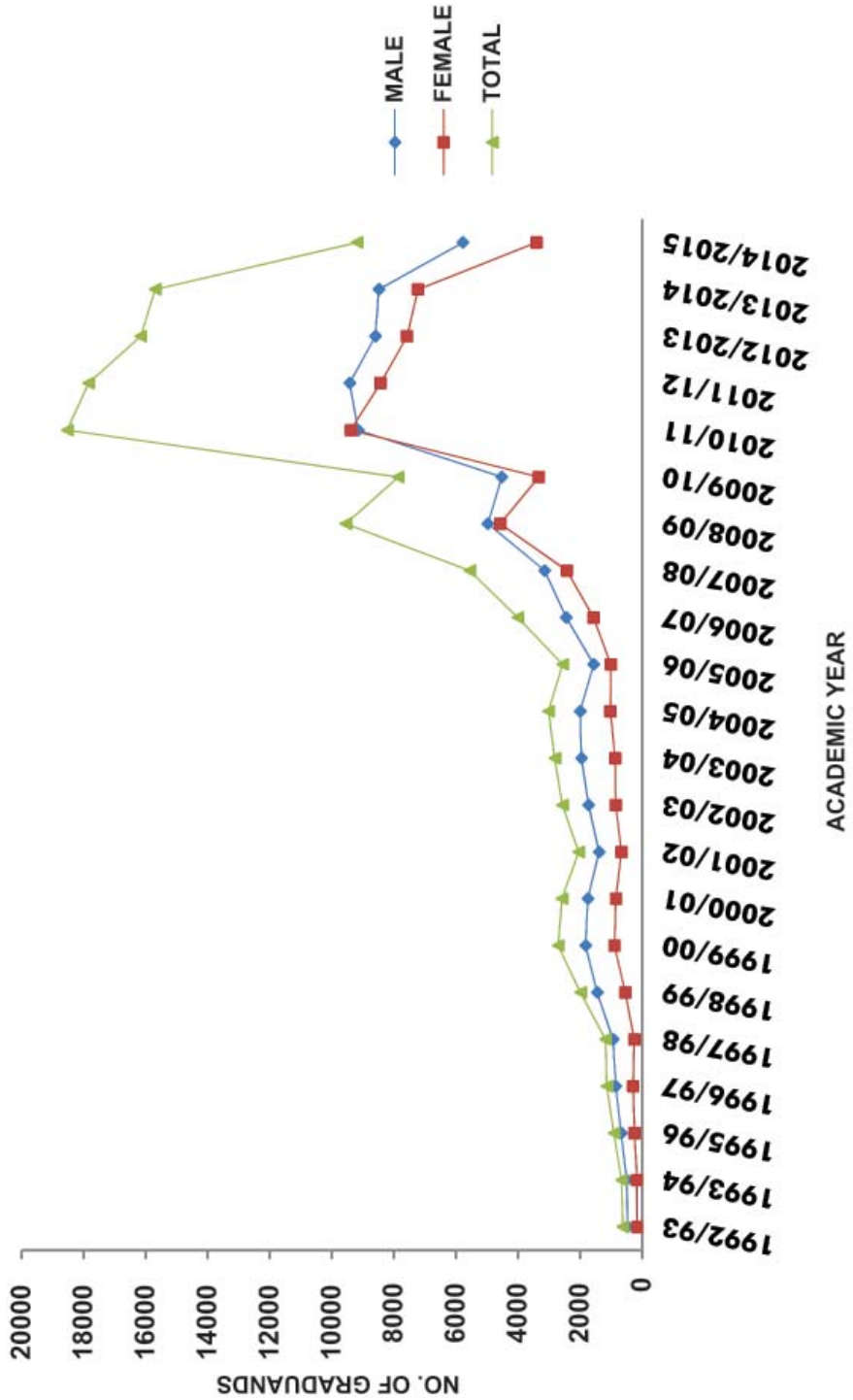

FIGURE 13: ACADEMIC STAFF PYRAMID, 2014/2015

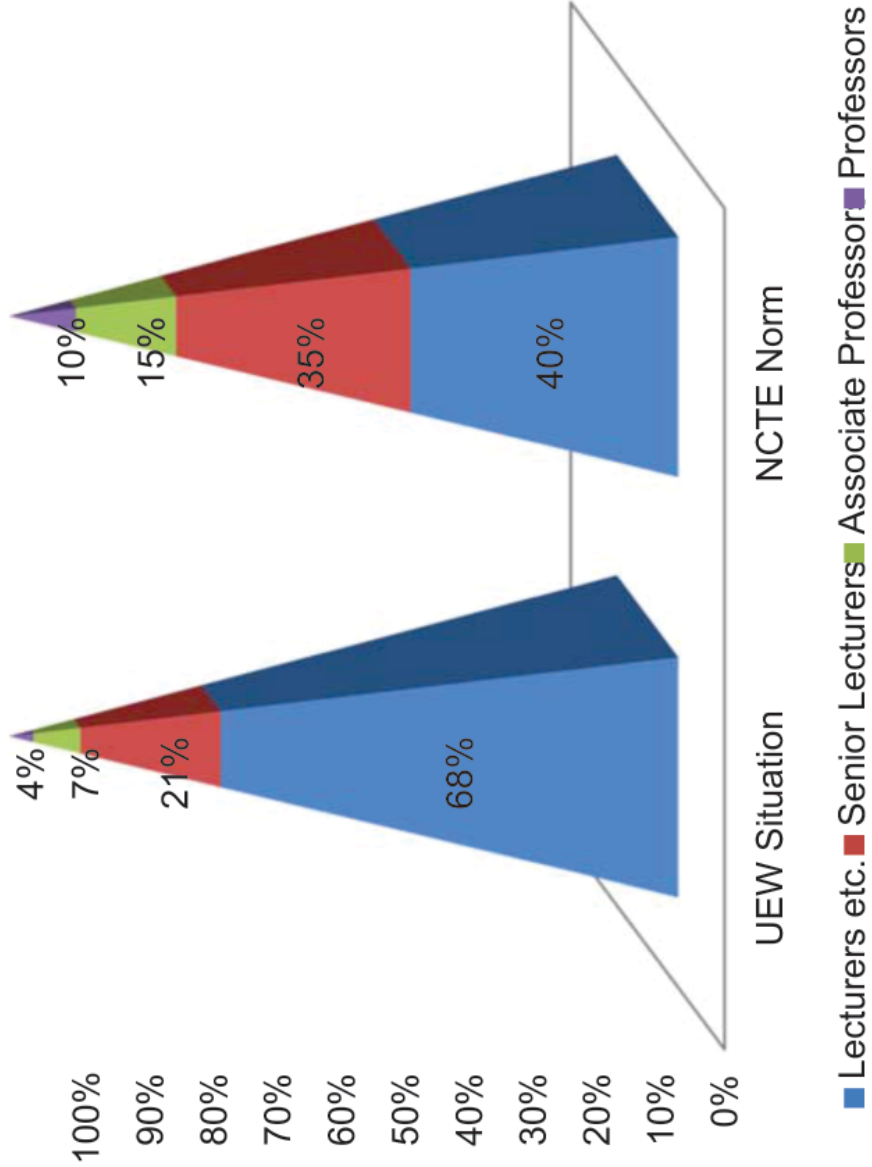
