What is ProQuest Ebook Central?

- ProQuest Ebook Central is a subscription based multidisciplinary ebook database.
- Provides hundreds of thousands of online full text books in all subject areas.
- Most of the books are in English, but there are a small number of titles in other languages including German, French, Italian, Spanish, Czech, Chinese and more.


How do I access the Ebook Central collection?

- Books through Ebook Central are accessed through the <u>ProQuest Ebook Central</u> Link on the University Library's Website.
- You will be required to login with your UEW Library Account in order to access and read the online book or download for offline reading.

Logging in to ProQuest Ebook Central

- Connect to the internet
- Go to <u>http://uew.edu.gh</u>
- Click on <u>Library</u>
- Click on <u>Ebooks</u>
- Click on ProQuest Ebook Central
- Login with Student ID as username and same as password
 - For example:
 - Username: 6140210214 (Student ID No.)
 - Password: 6140210214 (Student ID No.)
- Search, Browse subjects, read online, download, add to bookshelf etc.





When you are on-campus, you have automatic access if you are connected to the UEW WiFi.

For off-campus access however, one must login with their UEW student or staff account.

Off Campus Access to UEW Library's licensed e-Resources is available to current UEW students, faculty and staff.


For Faculty/Researchers/Staff, login with your UEW account (same account used to access online payslip/ Wi-Fi) to have access.


For Students, Login with your Student ID as username and same ID as your password.




Browsing & Searching

Browse Subjects



Basic Search

- Search using:
 - Keywords
 - Quotations to find phrases, e.g. "performing arts"
 - Boolean operators: AND, OR, or NOT
 - Connect terms with AND, e.g. "performing arts" AND history
 - Expand a search with OR, e.g. "performing arts" AND history OR criticism
 - Limit a search with NOT, e.g. "performing arts" NOT history




Advanced Search

- Search specific fields
- Limit by publication year and language
- Connect search terms without using Booleans

Full & Chapter Downloads

Can I download or print items in the collection?

- Ebook Central allows full downloads and chapter downloads.
- Downloads can be done on computers, tablets, or phones.

To download a complete book:


- Select the "Full Download" link
- Choose the device you are using
- Install <u>Adobe Digital</u> <u>Editions</u> (free)
- Create a free account to login
- Download your book

To download a pdf chapter:

- Select the "Download PDF Chapter" link
- Select the Chapter to download
- Click Download PDF

Can I download or print items in the collection?

- Full book downloads are limited up to 21 days. After this time period, the book will expire on your device.
- Chapter and page range download is also available and does not expire.
- There is a limit to the amount of pages available for download, which is indicated on the Availability section of the book.
- Ebook Central has print allowance for 40% of the book.



Your institution has access to multiple copies of this book.










Does Ebook Central include a citation tool?

- Yes
- On the left of the screen, look for the "Cite Book" link.
- Choose your citation style, and copy and paste the citation into your paper.
- You can also export the citation to Refworks or EndNote.





Is there a way to keep track of books or chapters I use frequently?

- Yes.
- You may add books to your "Bookshelf", via the Add to Bookshelf link.
- View books in your collections by clicking the Bookshelf link at the top of the page.
- Your Bookshelf tells you which books you've accessed, borrowed, or put in collections.
- The Bookshelf tab also allows you to view any annotations you've made in books, share a link to a folder, cite the folder, or manage books in your collection.

Can I read an ebook on my phone or tablet?

- Yes.
- Ebook Central is designed with mobile in mind.
- Download and install Adobe Digital Editions software on your mobile device.
- Access the site from your tablet or phone, and download ebooks for offline reading.

Can I download an ebook for Offline Access?

- ProQuest Ebook Central offers flexible options for downloading content.
- Select "Download" from the Book Details Page or the Online Reader itself.
- To download books for offline access, you will firstly need <u>Adobe Digital</u> <u>Editions</u> a free software that is different than Adobe Reader.
- If using a mobile device, the Adobe Digital Editions App is free from the <u>Apple App Store</u> and <u>Google Play</u>.
- You can use other reader apps as long as they are able to handle the Adobe DRM (Digital Rights Management).
- Search in the app store of your choice for e.g. 'adobe drm reader' or just 'adobe drm' to get a list of potentially suitable apps.

Can I download an ebook for Offline Access? - 2

- You do need an Adobe ID simply to read a downloaded book on one device.
- You can get an Adobe ID for free if you wish to transfer your downloaded eBook from one device to another.
- You will not need an <u>Adobe ID</u> if you continue to read it on the same device.
- Select the number of days you wish to download the book for.
- You should now be able to read the book offline on the Adobe Digital Editions Reader.

- You can download a chapter PDF from the Table of Contents on the Book Details Page.
- The PDFs are searchable, selectable, and include a citation and do not expire. Chapter downloads require users to sign-in to their Ebook Central account or continue as Guest.
- Benefits to signing in include increased copy, print and download allowances, access to your personal Ebook Central Bookshelf where you can save books, chapters, and create/save annotations – and it's free (and easy)!

- A chapter download is counted the same as print and will be taken into account by the allowances of the book.
- Each book's print/download and copy allowance is displayed on the Book Details page, and can vary depending on the publisher.
- Once you have printed/chapter downloaded a page, the allowance automatically counts down.
- You can also download a chapter or print pages through the Online Reader's icons.



- The Chapter Download Icon will allow you to download the current chapter.
- The Print icon will allow you to input a page range.
- It will then download those pages in PDF.
- In order to print, you must use your PDF Reader's print functionality.
