This course is designed to equip students with the skills to link epidemiological theory to population health and therapy and apply in health service and decision making. The course covers the essential knowledge that health service managers and planners need, concerning

epidemiology and population health. The course will also provide students with an opportunity to calculate and interpret measures of disease frequency, morbidity and their impact.
