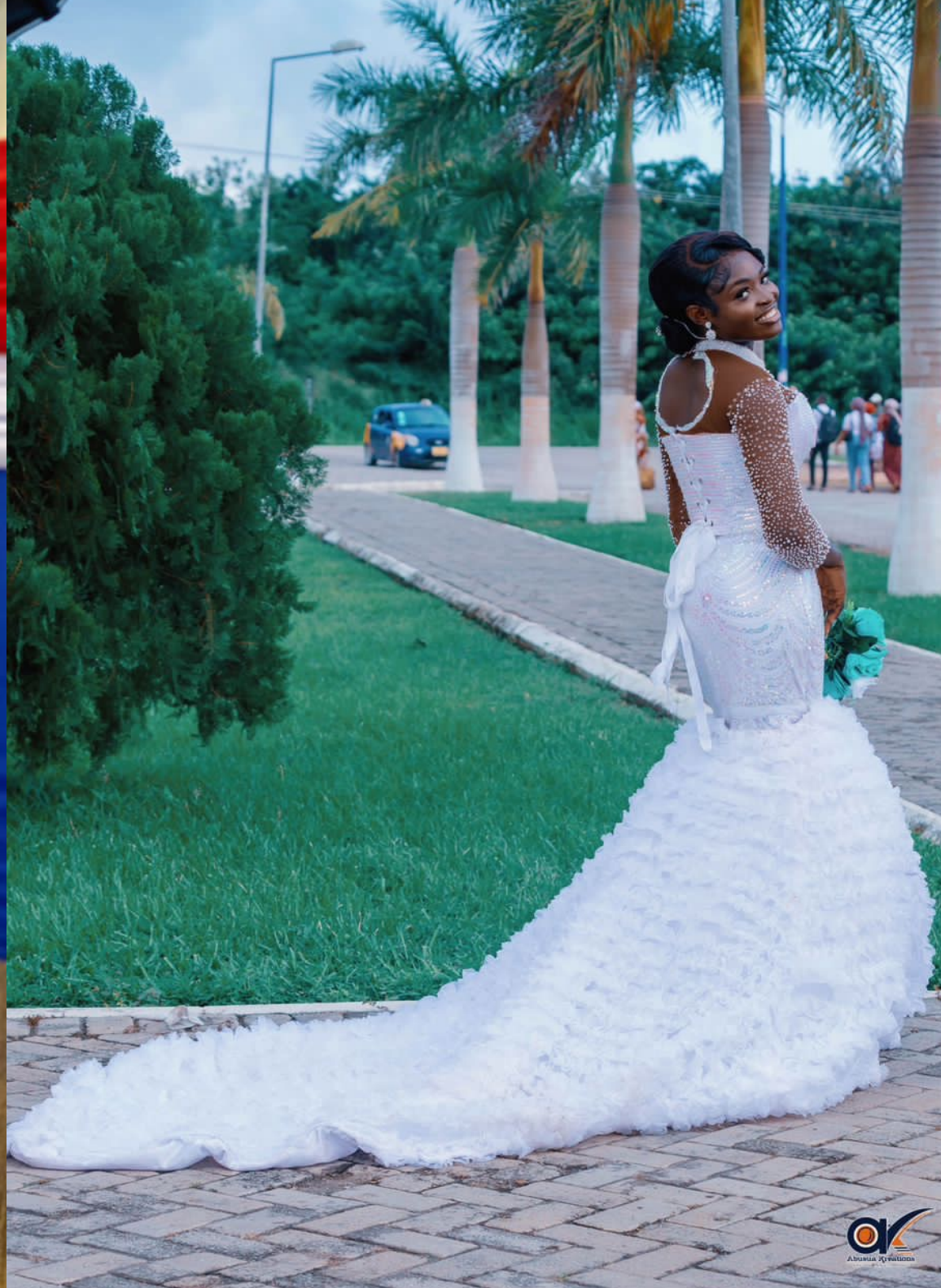
Additionally, it is meant to encourage students of the faculty and Senior High School students who shy away from Clothing and Textiles/Fashion to venture into it.

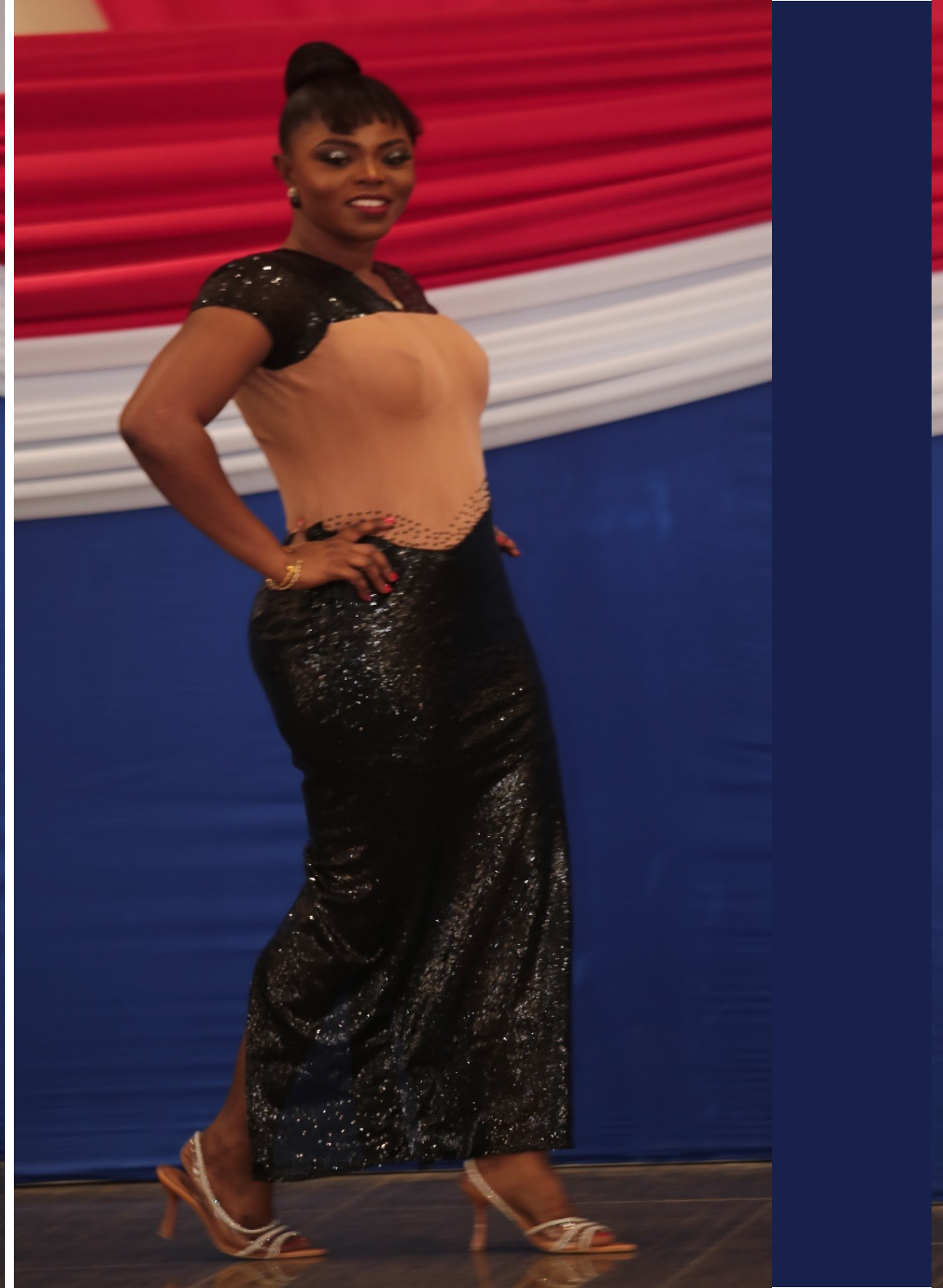






















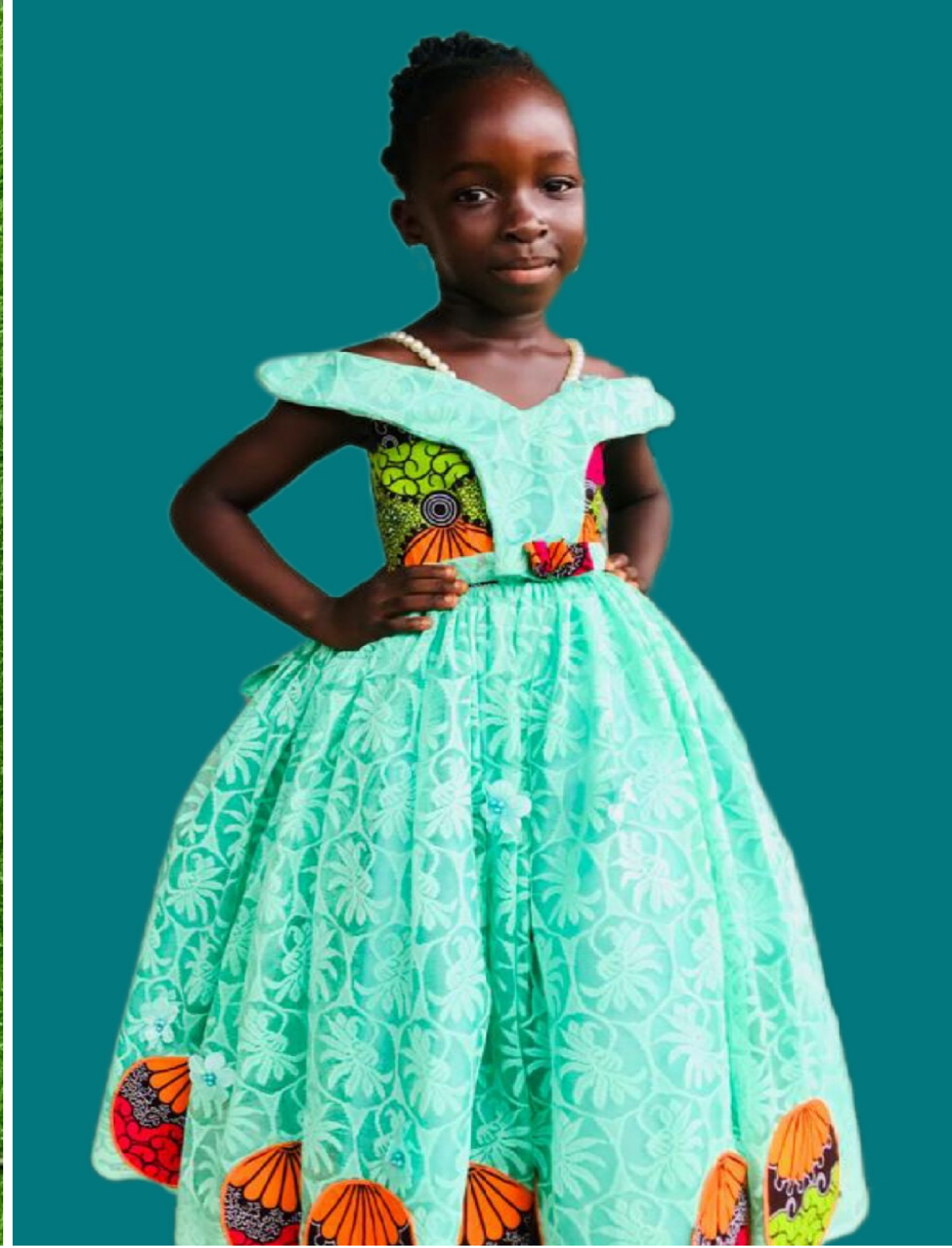
